CABOCHON JEWELLERY








HISTORY

Crown of Grace: Remembering Queen Sirikit's Dazzling Legacy

During my two months in Bangkok, the city shimmered with a quiet reverence. Queen Sirikit—the beloved Queen Mother of Thailand—had passed away, and her influence was felt in every golden temple and silk-draped boutique. Her image, eternally poised in pearls and sapphire, still watches over the kingdom she helped define through beauty, culture, and grace.

Often called Asia's Jackie Kennedy, Queen Sirikit transformed fashion into diplomacy. But it was her jewelry that truly spoke her language—an opulent blend of royal tradition and modern glamour. Her signature look paired lustrous Thai pearls with vivid sapphires, rubies, and diamonds, each piece echoing the colors of her nation. Whether draped in Balmain couture or traditional Thai silk, her jewels weren't mere adornment; they were expressions of identity, elegance, and cultural pride.

She championed Thai craftsmanship, nurturing the SUPPORT Foundation to preserve artisanal skills in weaving, goldwork, and gem-setting. Her collection reflected this devotion-intricate gold filigree necklaces, floral brooches inspired by lotus motifs, and cascading diamond earrings crafted by local masters.





INVESTMENTS

Electric Dreams: The Case for Investing in Paraiba Tourmaline

In the world of fine gemstones, few names elicit the same awe as Paraiba tourmaline. Its **neon glow** -an impossible fusion of turquoise, aqua, and electric blue-seems to radiate light from within. First discovered in the late 1980s in Brazil's Paraíba state, this rare gem has since become one of the most coveted and valuable stones on earth, with top-quality pieces commanding prices rivaling fine sapphires and even certain diamonds. What sets Paraiba apart is chemistry as much as mystique. Copper and manganese trace elements give it its signature luminescence—a phenomenon so vivid it's described as "lit from within." Deposits in Brazil are nearly exhausted, and while newer finds in Mozambique and Nigeria have extended supply, the original Brazilian stones remain the most prized. Their scarcity drives consistent appreciation in value, making Paraiba tourmaline a darling of high-jewelry houses and collectors alike.





If you'd bought a fine Brazilian-origin Paraíba around 2010-11, you were paying perhaps US\$10,000-20,000 per caratfor top-quality material. Today, equivalent stones can fetch US\$50,000-100,000+ per carat, especially for large sizes and vivid colour from the original Brazilian source.

In other words: over a 10-year horizon you could expect roughly a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 15-30% (depending on size, quality, origin) for best-in-class stones. One guide estimates average annual growth of ~12% (2012-2014), ~15% (2016-17) and even a 118% jump in 2022 for top material.

For investors, the **key is provenance and saturation**. Look for certified origin (Brazilian if possible), vivid electric color, and clean clarity. Even smaller stones can hold significant value if the color intensity is exceptional.

Owning a Paraiba tourmaline isn't just an investment-it's participation in a modern legend. In a market where rarity meets radiance, these gems embody the future of collectible luxury: tangible, mesmerizing, and eternally aglow.
