

GB UK STUDY VISA CHECKLIST

A. UNIVERSITY ADMISSION STAGE

1. **Valid Passport** (First four pages including previous visas and travel history)
2. **National ID (CNIC)** (Front and back)
3. **Educational Documents**
 - All academic degrees and transcripts (front and back)
 - ◆ Matric/Inter (IBCC attested)
 - ◆ Bachelor's/Master's (HEC and MOFA attested)
 - ◆ Apostille (if requested by university)
4. **Curriculum Vitae (CV)** (Updated in UK format)
5. **Statement of Purpose (SOP)** *(Sample will be provided)*
6. **Experience Letters** (Matching details from the CV (if applicable))
7. **Reference / Recommendation Letters** (Two academic/professional references With referee's contact info (email + phone))
8. **English Language Proficiency**
 - IELTS UKVI Academic / SELT
 - Some universities accept:
 - ◆ Duolingo / PTE Academic
 - ◆ Medium of Instruction Letter (if accepted by university)
9. **Passport-Sized Photographs** (As per UKVI biometric specifications)
10. **Application Fee Payment Receipt** *(if applicable)*
11. **Conditional or Unconditional Offer Letter from University**
12. **Interview Preparation Support** *(Provided by our team)*

B. VISA APPLICATION STAGE (AFTER ADMISSION)



Documents for UK Student Visa (Student Route – D Type):

1. **Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS)**
 - Issued by the university after deposit payment and document verification
 - Includes your personal details, course info, fees, and sponsor license number
2. **Visa Fee Payment** (Standard fee: £490)
3. **Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS)** (£776 per year (paid online during application)
4. **Valid Passport** (With minimum 6 months validity and blank pages)

5. Financial Evidence

(Must be in the account for at least 28 days before application date)

- Tuition balance + 9 months of living expenses:
 - ◆ **Inside London:** £1,334/month = £12,006
 - ◆ **Outside London:** £1,023/month = £9,207
- Funds can be held by:
 - ◆ Student
 - ◆ Parent (requires: Affidavit of Support + Birth Certificate + CNIC)

6. Bank Statement

- Original or certified copy
- Dated within 31 days before visa application
- In English, showing account title, number, bank stamp/logo, and currency

7. Bank Maintenance / Solvency Letter

- Confirming the bank details and funds have been held for 28+ days

8. Tuberculosis (TB) Test Certificate

- From an **approved UKVI clinic** (mandatory for Pakistani applicants)

9. Academic Documents

- Same documents used to obtain admission
- Include degree certificates, transcripts, and English language proof

10. Accommodation Proof *(optional but helps)*

- University accommodation letter or rental agreement

11. ATAS Certificate *(Only for certain postgraduate STEM courses)*

12. CAS Checklist Confirmation

- Must match submitted documents

NOTES & GUIDANCE

- All documents must be in **English** or **certified translated**.
- Visa interviews (Credibility Interviews) are common – preparation is essential.
- Fund sources should be clear and traceable – avoid unexplained large deposits.
- Avoid using agents who submit fake documents – this leads to bans and refusals.
