US USA STUDENT VISA (F-1) – DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST

PHASE 1: UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Valid Passport (must be valid at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in the U.S.)
- 2. National Identity Document (CNIC/NICOP) (Front and back)
- 3. Educational Documents
 - Matric & Inter certificates (IBCC attested)
 - Bachelor's/Master's degrees (HEC + MOFA attested)
 - Transcripts (front & back)
 - Apostille (if required)
- 4. Standardized Test Scores IELTS / TOEFL / Duolingo / PTE / SAT (for undergrad), GRE / GMAT (for grad programs)
- 5. Updated Resume / CV (Clearly list academic and work history)
- 6. Statement of Purpose (SOP) Personalized for course and university (Team will provide guidance/sample)
- 7. Recommendation Letters (2) (Academic or professional references with Contact Details)
- 8. Experience Letters (if applicable) (As mentioned in your resume)
- Passport-Sized Photographs (US visa-compliant (2" x 2", white background))
- 10. University Application Form / Portal Submission
- 11. Conditional or Unconditional Offer Letter

PHASE 2: VISA DOCUMENTS (AFTER ADMISSION)

Essential Documents for F-1 Visa (Student Route)

- 1. Form I-20 (Issued by SEVP-certified university / Signed by student and Designated School Official (DSO))
- SEVIS Fee Payment Receipt (\$350 (paid online at fmjfee.com)
- 3. DS-160 Confirmation Page Completed online visa form (ceac.state.gov)
- 4. Visa Appointment Confirmation Letter Booked via ustraveldocs.com
- 5. Visa Fee Payment Receipt (\$185 paid online or via designated bank)
- Valid Passport (Original passport + any expired passports)
- 7. Recent Passport Photo (US-compliant photo to bring to the interview)

PHASE 3: FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS FOR VISA INTERVIEW

- 1. Bank Statement
 - Showing full 1-year funds (tuition + living costs)
 - Must cover:
 - Tuition fees (mentioned in I-20)
 - Living expenses (usually \$10,000-\$15,000/year)
 - Funds must be available for at least 28 consecutive days
- 2. Bank Account Maintenance Certificate
 - From the same bank as the statement
- 3. Affidavit of Support (if sponsored)
 - Notarized on Rs.100 stamp paper
 - Sponsor's CNIC and relationship proof
- 4. Relationship Proof with Sponsor
 - Birth Certificate or Family Registration Certificate
- 5. Proof of Income / Source of Funds
 - Salary slips, tax returns, business registration, etc.
- 6. Property/Asset Documents (optional)
 - To show strong financial backing

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS FOR INTERVIEW

- All original academic documents
- Standardized test reports (IELTS, TOEFL, GRE, etc.)
- I-20 + university admission letters
- Financial and sponsor documentation
- Strong ties to home country (job offers, family business, etc.)

NOTES

- All documents must be in English or certified translated
- Prepare thoroughly for your visa interview it determines approval
- Clearly explain: why USA, why this university/course, career plans, and how you'll fund your studies
- The credibility of your financials and SOP is crucial
