




Greetings from Applewood United Church!

We are a suburban congregation nestled in the Applewood Acres neighbourhood just west of the Toronto border in Mississauga and less than 4 km from the Lake Ontario shoreline. The congregation was formed in 1953, and our building completed in 1956. Over the years we have had some major renovations but also welcomed the St. Luke's on the Hill and the Bethesda United Church families to create a 'new' Applewood UC in 2003, and became an Affirming Congregation in 2014. We have seen other changes in our neighbourhood and our congregation over the years, and we face the same challenges as many other faith communities in this time, but we continue our ministry together - with hope, and with "Deep Spirituality, Bold Discipleship and Daring Justice."
