Centenary Pastoral Charge was formed in 1967 with the coming together of Sharbot Lake United Church, Parham United Church and Maberly United Church (now closed). All these Ontario churches were former Methodist congregations.

Each of our two rural village churches averages about 15 attendees each Sunday at our 10 a.m. service (Sharbot Lake) and 11:30 a.m. service (Parham). We are located in beautiful cottage country so our congregations grow somewhat in the summer.

We manage without technology as rural internet can still be problematic.

We are served by a part time retired minister and feel very fortunate as most of the surrounding United Churches manage with lay leadership and occasional visiting clergy.

We have a small choir at Sharbot Lake and a small U.C.W. and a weekly Bible study. We support our local food bank and local Christmas basket appeal as well as doing our part for Mission and Service and Gifts with Vision projects. We have an annual mission project and this year we will be supporting United Church Camp QuinMoLac.
