



The Birsay United Church is part of the Coteau Hills Pastoral Charge, a two-point charge located in a rural agricultural community in Saskatchewan. We do not have a resident minister, instead, we hire pulpit supply to provide services on the second and forth Sundays of the month from September to June. The population of Birsay is 50, with more living outside of town in the surrounding area. Although the average regular attendance is ten, many folks who at once lived in Birsay continue to support their beloved church. It was built in 1928 by hard working pioneers and its dedicated members look forward to celebrating its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in a few years.
