

Tales of Nagars and Colonies | AGS Colony

AGS Colony in Nanganallur is a neighbourhood known for its peaceful environment, thoughtful layout and strong sense of community. Spread across six streets, the colony stands out for its well-planned structure.

One of the unique features of the area is that there are no dead-end roads, allowing residents and visitors to move freely through the streets and exit from different points of the neighbourhood. This connected layout adds to the convenience and charm of the colony.

In the first episode of the "Tales, Nagars and Colonies of Nanganallur" series

by Nanganallur Connect, the story of AGS Colony is shared through conversations with Mr. Swaminathan, President of the AGS Colony Association, and Mr. Kothandaraman, its Secretary. They spoke about the colony's history, the people who shaped it and the community spirit that continues to thrive today. According to them, the first residents of AGS Colony were Mr. L. Ramasubramanian and his wife, Mrs. V. Ramasubbalakshmi, who were among the earliest to settle in the area when it was still developing. Along with Mr. P.C. Vaidyanathan and Mr. Krishnan, they later

became the founding pillars of the AGS Colony Association, laying the foundation for an organised and active residential community.

Over the years, the residents' association has played an important role in bringing people together and maintaining the sense of unity within the colony. In earlier days, New Year celebrations were conducted on a large scale, jointly with the State Bank Colony Extension Association at the grounds near the Vinayagar Temple. These celebrations became memorable occasions for families across the neighbourhood. The association also continues to organise Independence Day and Republic Day celebrations, which see enthusiastic participation from residents of all age groups. Such events help strengthen the bonds within the community and keep the spirit of togetherness alive. AGS Colony is also home to important landmarks such as the Vinayagar Temple, which serves as a spiritual centre for residents and

plays a key role in many local activities. The area is also known for institutions like Modern Senior Secondary School, which has become a familiar educational landmark for many families in Nanganallur. Adding to the cultural and spiritual life of the neighbourhood is Durga Mandali, a women-led spiritual group that conducts devotional activities and brings together women in the colony through prayer gatherings and cultural participation.

Through its active residents' association, its cultural traditions and its strong neighbourly bonds, AGS Colony continues to reflect the warmth and unity that Nan-



Old memories are gold memories. When it is about places, landmarks - mostly buildings, which remain for decades or even ages, fill our memories. For Nanganallur some of the prominent landmarks are Chidambaram Stores, Ranga Theatre (Vetrivel Theatre), and Modern School. All the three are sure to have a connect with most of the residents of Nanganallur. These are given as guiding points for visitors and e-com executives to easily reach the destinations.

The Coffee Corner of the mini-metro

Near Roja Medicals, at the junction of 4th Main Road and 6th Main Road, three cafés - Thiraviyam Coffee, Alive Coffee, and Coffee Shastra - face one another. Each has its own price range and atmosphere, yet all three are almost always busy. That, perhaps, is the beauty of Nanganallur - different choices, but a shared neighbourhood life. Undisputably Nanganallur displays a typical trait of Tamil Nadu - Coffee

Just uttering Nanganallur pushes in a sense of divinity - undisputably because of the plethora of temples present across the length and breadth of our locality and that is why the epithet Little Kanchi. Fine, everyone - both Nanganallureans and visitors from far and near - gets this feel. This fact apart, have we ever attempted to know the count of Nagars and Colonies spread within the boundaries of Nanganallur. When we say Nanganallur boundary, practically locals start it from Pazhavanthangal - the northern gateway to the locality - and go in a circle from there via the pockets abutting the railway track to College Road touching the western end of Nehru Colony, Poonthottam Street stretching to Bakthavatsalam nagar, Rathinapuram, Burma Colony Moo-

varasanpet, Kannan Nagar, East Main Road, Kanniga Colony, Mangayarkarasi Nagar, Adyar Anandha Bhavan, Murugan temple, first main road junction, Ram Nagar and end at Thillai Ganga Nagar connecting back to Pazhavanthangal.

Notably, old and popular layouts are the Central sector around the market, TG Nagar, Ram Nagar Lakshmi Nagar, Hindu Colony, State Bank Colony Extn, Voltas Colony, MMTC Colony and not to be missed out Bakthavatsalam

Nagar. A random count by Team NC revealed that around 40 residential layouts inter-connected by around 550 roads form part of Nanganallur. A notable aspect of the road infra is that spotting streets less than 23ft in width is a rarity and dead-ends too are handful. Planners have been meticulous in designing the layouts to ensure navigation convenience for even visitors too and losing track is near to impossibility. Temples are important landmarks in Nanganallur's geography. More important is the role of shrines in keeping the local economy at a steady pace as small and big shops are assured of round-the-year business. With the population being a mix of middle and upper middle income groups, affordability is not a debate when it comes to purchasing power. Sensible in their spending and savings, Nanganallureans have

always been ready to pay for quality. A stroll through Nanganallur will throw up umpteen proofs in the form of all private, PSU and small banks, various financial and allied institutions, branches of leading chain of hotels to pizza outlets, consumer appliance and modern gadget (cell phone to computers, etc.) sellers of repute. Similarly, education institutions on par with their peers at state level catering to all sections of society show that Nanganallur is ideal for each and every strata of income groups. Parks for parents - (middle aged to those in their sunset), theatres for youth and bachelors and indoor games space and playstation for kids and teens - Nanganallur has numerous relax spots for all age groups. Unarguably, Nanganallur ticks every box that any city will require to be called a metro within the Metro Chennai.

Time for Homemakers TO STEP ON THE GAS



People should act responsibly to minimise the impact on both households and on the nation

The West Asia crisis, whether it is continuing or concluded, has sounded a timely and much-necessary alarm over the need to use liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) judiciously in households and also in commercial establishments. The Gulf tensions has thrown a tough challenge to public and businesses in every country and it is sure to have an all-round effect on daily life and skyrocket inflation too.

On its part, the Indian government has initiated several emergency measures to minimise the pain of the consumers and tide over the crisis sans much hassles.

People should act responsibly and smartly to minimise the impact on both their households and on their respective nations. Here are

some tips and suggestions for energy-efficient cooking habits.

Some of the key practices must be use of pressure cookers, keeping burners clean for a blue flame, and turning off the regulator when not in use.

Pressure Cookers

This is one of the most effective ways to save fuel, reducing consumption by up to 50-70% for certain foods.

Pre-soak Ingredients

Soaking rice, lentils, and pulses before cooking reduces the required cooking time and fuel.

Use Lids

Cover pans and pots while cooking to trap heat, which cooks food faster and reduces gas consumption.

Moderate Flame Use

Keep the flame within the bottom surface of the utensil; flames spreading up the sides waste energy.

Prep in Advance

Keep all chopped ingredients, spices, and utensils ready before lighting the stove to avoid wasting gas while preparing.

Avoid Overcooking

Monitor food to avoid excess boiling, which wastes fuel.

Use Proper Utensils

Opt for wide, flat-bottomed vessels that allow for even, faster heat transfer.

Clean Regularly

Clean burners frequently to prevent soot buildup, which causes inefficient, orange/yellow flames that consume more gas.

In fact, these practices must be followed at all times and should not be seen as a crisis management.

Such responsible acts by citizens will save a lot for their households, besides cutting a huge sum on imports bill for the government. The saved funds will pave the way for several new development initiatives by government.



IIT Madras Director Kamakoti, and other important community moments and interviews.



Rama Navami celebrations from March 20-29 at Anjaneyar temple

A host of rituals and celebrations have been planned by the 32-foot Sri Anjaenya Temple for the 10-day Rama Navami festival at the Sri Kothandarama Swamy shrine located inside its premises from March 20 to March 29.

The celebrations will include Laksharchanai and special yajnas, along with several important rituals by priests and vedic scholars besides devotional events for devotees. The festival will begin on March 20 with the Laksharchanai, which will continue for days during 10-day programme.

On March 21, special Sandana Kaapu Alankaram and Deeparadhanai will be performed for Lord Kothandarama. On March 22, devotees can watch special abishekams (including palabishekam). Sri Sita-Rama Thirukalyanam Utsavam, the highlight of the 10-day festival, will be performed later on the same day.

Yagasala poojas and other important rituals will be conducted on subsequent days. The main Sri Rama Navami celebration featuring special rituals like Tirumanjanam, Poornahuthi, Kalasa Abishekam and special alankaram will be conducted on March 27. Laksharchanai and a ceremonial procession of the deity will mark the conclusion of celebrations on March 29.


