Crosscut quilt block

Each quilt block is made with 3 different fabrics

Fabric 1 - This is for the X – bright colors – These can be scraps with like color.

Fabric 2 - Light -reading white for two large corners and center corner

Fabric 3 - Dark - reading black for two large corners and center corner

Alternate color scheme – bright colors for x, fabrics reading white for all corners

Cutting

Fabric 1 Cut (4) 8" squares

Fabric 2 Cut (4) 5" squares and (2) 3 1/2" squares

Fabric 3 Cut (4) 5" squares and (2) 3 1/2" squares

Each block has 4 units – Make 2 matching sets for a block

Draw a diagonal line across all 5" and 3 $\ensuremath{\ensuremath{\mathcal{Y}}}$ blocks

Block set 1 – make 2

- 1. Align a 5" block on the upper right side of the block. *Diagram 1*
- 2. Sew the along diagonal line. Repeat on the opposite square. *Diagram 2*
- 3. Trim away excess fabric and press seam allowance down on both corners. *Diagram 4*
- 4. Sew 3 ½' square on the lower right side of the block. *Diagram 3*
- 5. Trim and press seam toward corner.

Block set 2 – make 2

- Repeat the process above but press all large seams up *Diagram 5*
- 2. Press 3 ½' toward main fabric Diagram 5

Finishing:

- 1. Join the 4 block units to finish the block.
- 2. The seams should nest.
- 3. Block should measure 15 $\ensuremath{\,^{\prime\prime}\!\!\!\!\!}^\prime$ and finish at 15 ''
