Note on Fellowship Eligibility and Cultural Involvement

1. **Age Requirement:** The applicant must be **below 30 years of age** at the time of fellowship commencement.
2. **Cultural Involvement:** Preference will be given to individuals who have demonstrated active cultural engagement, such as:
 - Possession of **State or Central-level certificates** in cultural activities.
 - Holding a **Visharad degree** or equivalent certification in **classical dance** or **cultural singing**.
3. **Alignment with Competitive Examination Goals:**
The fellowship is designed to support the academic and personal development of youth preparing for **competitive examinations**. Cultural involvement is seen as a strength that enriches personality and enhances performance in interviews and other evaluation stages.
4. **Other Considerations:**
 - Preference will also be given to individuals with an **NSS background** or those who are **State/National-level sports players**.
 - **Educational Qualification:** A minimum of **60% marks** in either **Class 12** or **Graduation**.
 - **Selection Priority:** Candidates demonstrating a balance of **IQ (Intelligence Quotient)** and **EQ (Emotional Quotient)**, with a deep commitment to **human values** and the **spirit of India's freedom movement**.
