Fall Festival of Quilts

September 19-20, 2025

Master Division – If **Any** of the following statements are true; you must enter under the “Master” Division:

- You are a quilter or maker of wearable art and you sell/have sold your work for profit.
- You teach/have taught quilting or wearable art techniques.
- You have had a quilt compete in the master Division of any quilt show in the past
- You have published a quilt or wearable art book or pattern.
- You have won a total of two or more blue ribbons in any combination of the following : county, state, national, or international quilting competitions.
- You have one a Best of Show Ribbon.
- You have had a quilt or garment juried into a highly prestigious exhibit (Ex: Quilt National, The Houston Quilt show, etc.)

Artisan Division – If **ALL** of the following statements are true, you may enter under the “Artisan” Division:

- You have never sold your work for profit.
- You have never formally taught quilting or wearable art techniques.
- You have never been classified as a “Master” in the past at any show.
- You have never published a pattern or a book on quilting/wearable art techniques.
- You have won no more than one blue ribbon in any combination of the following: county, state, national, or international quilting competitions.
- You have never had a quilt or garment juried into a highly prestigious exhibit.

Junior Division – Any quilter under the age of 15

First time Entrant – You have never entered in any kind of quilt show before.

Non-Judged Entries – Exempt from entry fees. Still need to submit a photo. Will be on display only.
