- The Secure Community Network (SCN) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit and The Official Safety and Security Organization of the Jewish community in North America.
- SCN was founded in 2004 by Jewish Federations of North America and Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, in coordination with federal partners, to address rising virtual and physical threats against the Jewish community.
- SCN serves as the nation’s central security and threat management hub, dedicated to educating, protecting, coordinating and communicating with 50 key national partners, 146 Jewish Federations, and over 400 independent/smaller communities, as well as government and law enforcement – exclusively to protect the safety and security of the North American Jewish community.
- SCN is committed to ensuring that Jewish communities, worship, life, and culture can *not only exist safely and securely, but flourish.*

Monitoring and Acting on Threats

The community’s largest team of analysts uses SCN’s proprietary Project RAIN™ to proactively identify threats and disseminate information to professional security directors in SCN-managed and Independent CSIs, Partners, SCN-Powered Regional Threat Centers, Embedded Analyst Programs, and Federal, State, and Local law enforcement.

Securing Facilities

SCN security experts offer facility assessments and recommendations to harden and protect facilities in your community. Our expert grant writing team helps guide you through government and other grant application processes, like the Nonprofit Security Grant Program, start-to-finish to make security upgrades possible.

Empowering Communities Through Training

SCN delivers *turnkey* local CSIs *as-a-service*. We hire and manage professionals, who use best practices to train, assess, protect, and report to law enforcement with your organization. SCN-powered CSIs are supported by SCN’s Jewish Security Operations Command Center™ (JSOCC™), operating 24x7, Project RAIN™ (Real-Time Actionable Intelligence Network™) threat management technology, and national network of 11 regional, and over 100 local, security director colleagues.

Coordinating with Law Enforcement and Other Faith-based Communities

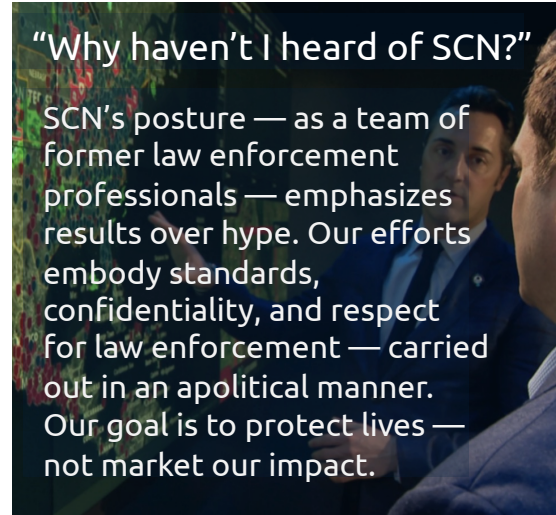

SCN is the only trusted partner with direct reporting access to the FBI National Threat Operations Center (NTOC). SCN also works closely with other faith-based organizations, leveraging the SCN platform to help keep everyone safe.

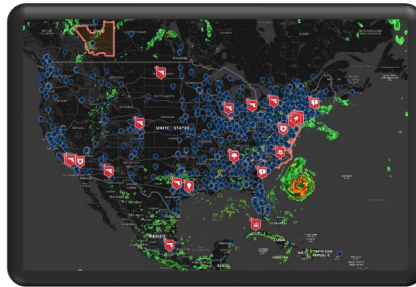

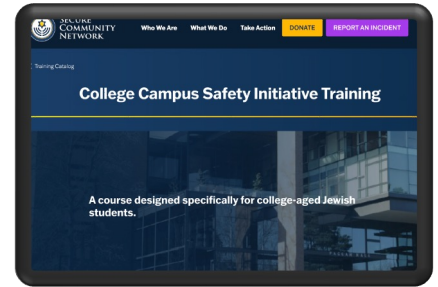
