WHAT IS AND HOW TO MUN

Imagine stepping into a room buzzing with excitement, where students sit behind nameplates labeled "France," "India," or "Brazil" or "Narendra Modi" Each person represents a country or a Leader, tasked with addressing a challenge—like climate change or fair elections. This is **Model United Nations** (MUN), a simulation of the United Nations where participants, called delegates, learn diplomacy by role-playing world leaders.

- **Representing a Portfolio:** Each delegate represents a country or leader, defending its policies on allotted **topics** like climate change or world security.
- **Committees and Agendas:** Delegates are placed in committees (e.g., Security Council or Lok Sabha) with specific **topics** to address.
- **Debates and Resolutions:** Through speeches, debates, and teamwork, delegates propose and negotiate solutions and score marks.

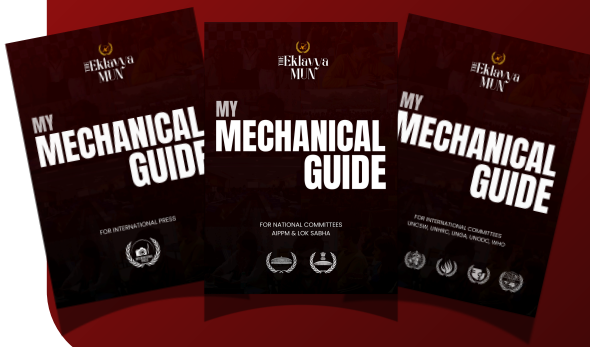

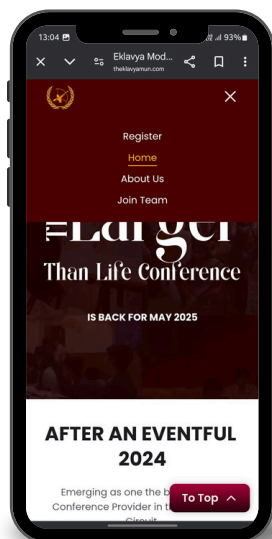

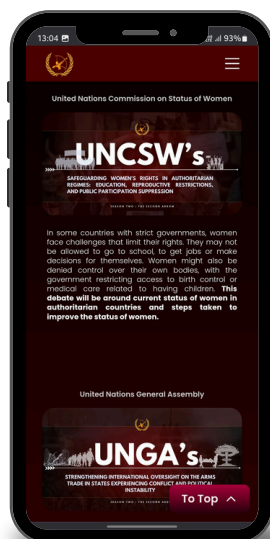

Go on [Home page](#), from here, click on Menu, Select Register. It will redirect you to **"Choose Committee"** page.



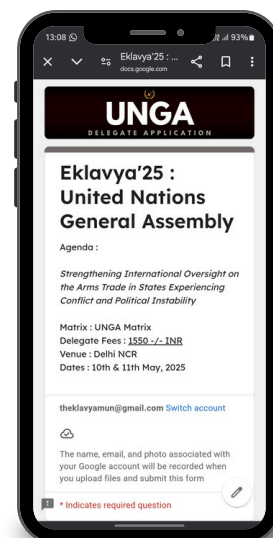
