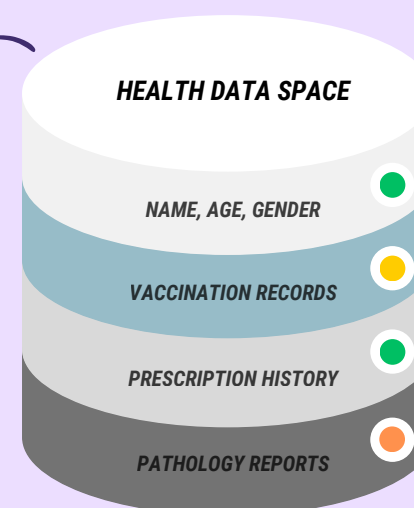

# Simplifying EU rules and boosting competitiveness

Part of the Competitiveness Compass, two packages aimed collectively at significantly reducing administrative burdens, namely by 25% for large companies and 35% for SMEs, were presented.

While they both aim to simplify and strengthen the EU's sustainability information and due diligence frameworks (CS3D, CSRD, CBAM), they have different focus:

### Omnibus I

Postpones their application dates



- CS3D: by one year
- CSRD: 2025 -> 2027 & 2026 -> 2028



### Omnibus II

Amends them

- CSRD: new scope applying to companies employing more than 1,000 people and with total assets or net sales in excess of €25 million
- CBAM: introduction of a threshold excluding 182,000 small importers
