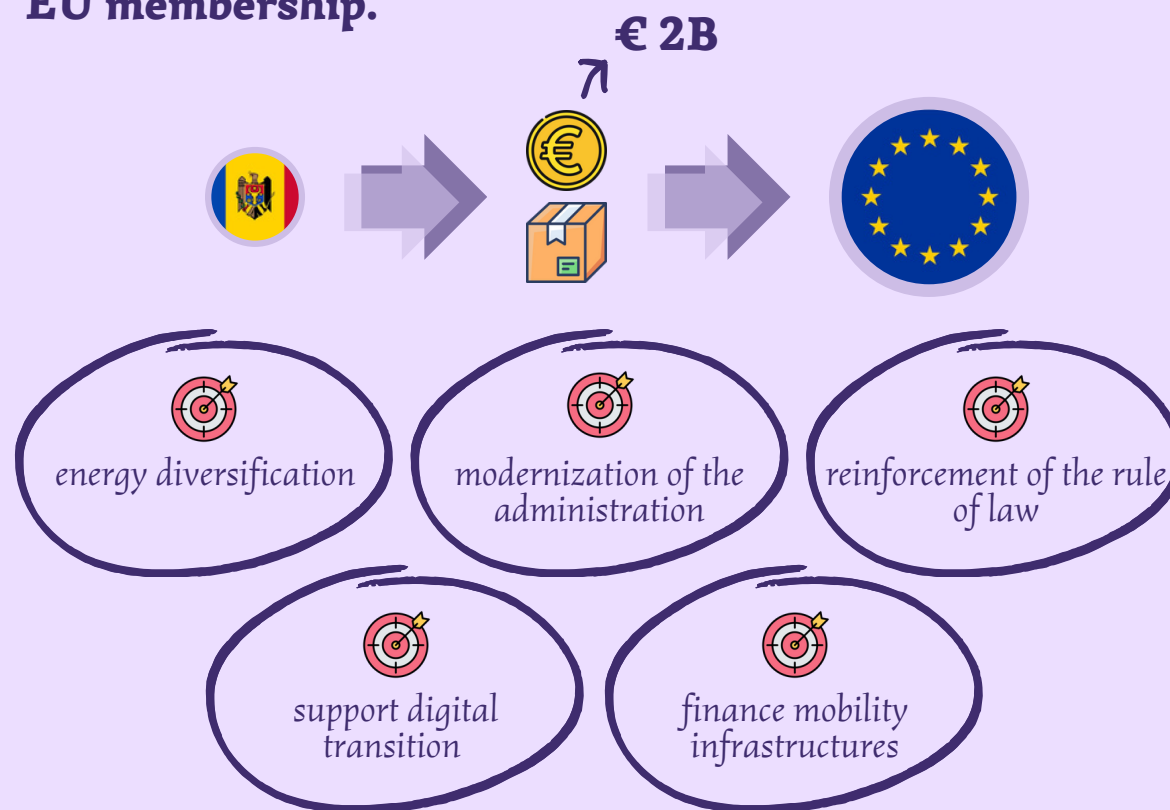

Despite tools being developed, such as the Emergency Response Coordination Centre, rescEU and Strategic Compass initiatives, the EU clearly lacks a unified, forward-looking risk governance architecture.
