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Regulation establishing the Internal Market Emergency and Resilience Act (IMERA)

This Regulation introduces the vigilance and emergency models, aimed to protect the integrity and continuity of the Internal Market from disruptions.

Vigilance

Allow early detection of potential threats

Based on Commission's monitoring data and risk assessments

Deactivated once threats are assessed as minimal or manageable

MS and EC share early warning data on supply chains, production capacities and goods availability



Emergency

Manage immediate crisis, ensuring continuity and addressing critical shortages

Requires evidence of disruption and approval by the Council

Deactivated once stability is restored

MS and EC share real-time data, rapid updates and close monitoring



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Directive on improving working conditions in platform work



This directive empowers workers' working conditions in the gig economy by :

Provision 1

Clarifying employment status

Every worker under direction or control by a platform is considered an employee

Provision 3

Ensuring data privacy

Prohibition for platforms to use biometric data for general identification purposes

Restriction for platforms to collect data on workers' personal, non-work-related, emotional state and private conversations

Provision 2

Empowering workers' rights

Right to human review of decisions made by automated systems

Right to access information about decisions made by automated systems on task assignment, earnings and performance evaluation

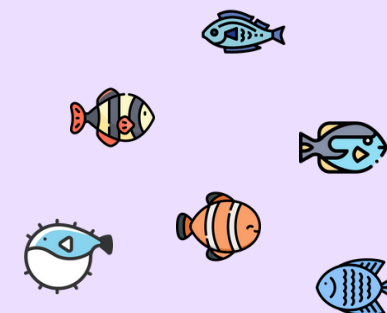

This proposal for a Council Regulation sets TACs and quotas for various fish stocks.

The objective is to ensure that fisheries practices and exploitation rates are sustainable, based on scientific assessments



Fish species (stock and prohibited species)



Cod, Haddock, Herring, Mackerel, Sole, Plaice, Saithe, Whiting, etc.

Maritime Regions Covered



North Sea, Baltic Sea, Skagerrak and Kattegat, Irish Sea, Bay of Biscay, etc.

Allocation for EU and non-EU vessels



EU-27, Norway, United Kingdom



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
