Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

- Open to individuals aged 18 or over. a.
- Members must reside in Australia.

Membership

Membership is limited to 100 members 'Associates'.

Subscription Fee

- An annual fee of \$500 per associate.
- Annual fee can comprise of up to \$250 in goods/services (only as agreed by NRC) and the remainder in cash.
- Payment must be made in full prior to the receipt of any benefits and to be eligible for the prize draw.
- Payments are non-refundable unless the draw is cancelled.

Subscription benefits

- Signage a.
 - i. size of up to 1500mm x 1000mm
 - sign to be provided by and cost borne by the 100 Club associate
 - location of signage to be determined by the NRC
 - NRC reserves the right to refuse to erect any signage it deems inappropriate.

Free entry tickets

- 6 (six) free tickets per race day
- Can be transferred to any person (gifted)
