Stygian, a Nordic folk horror film, is entering a new phase — evolving from a one-person effort into a fully-fledged international indie production. With an expanded vision and a world-class team now in place, the original grassroots funding campaign is concluding as the team prepares for a more ambitious relaunch this October.

"I'm incredibly proud and grateful to present the team behind Stygian," says writer-director Alexander Granström. "Everyone involved plays a key role in bringing this vision to life. We're at the threshold of creating something amazing."

After losing everything, a man retreats into the Nordic wilderness—only to find himself haunted by an ancient presence, as reality begins to unravel deep in the silence of the forest.
