

# SUMMER PROGRAMME 2025

#### NO NEED TO BOOK - JUST TURN UP

Monday 12th May 2025, 17:30 History of the Upper Plym Valley.

#### Led by Win Scutt B.A. DTLIS, MCIA,FSA. Senior Properties Curator(West) English Heritage.

The area comprises an extensive multi-period archaeological landscape including ceremonial and funerary monuments of presumed Neolithic and early Bronze Age date; land divisions, some 250 surviving hut circles and enclosures of presumed mid- to late Bronze Age date; evidence of tin and peat extraction, rabbit warrening and farming of medieval and post-medieval date; as well as infrastructure associated with 20th-century china clay extraction.
