In Happy Boules, you can play solo (1 vs 1), or in teams (2 vs 2 or 3 vs 3). The goal? Simple! Throw your boules and get them as close as possible to the small red jack, which is tossed at the start of each round. The team with the boules closest to the jack wins the round—easy, right?

2

A randomly selected player throws the jack at a distance between 3 and 7 meters, depending on the age of the players, so everyone gets a fair and fun challenge!

The player who throws the jack goes first, aiming to place their boule as close as possible to it. The other team plays next, trying to get their boule closer. If they succeed, the first team keeps playing until they can place their boule closer—or until they've used all their boules. The game continues until all boules are played.

4

Once all boules have been thrown, the distance between the jack and the closest boules is measured. The team with the closest boule scores 1 point for each of their boules that is closer than the opponent's closest boule.

5

The game ends when a team reaches a total of 13 points
