

# Pinecone Turkey



## Supplies

1. Pinecone
2. Paint and paintbrush
3. Pom
4. Eyes
5. Felt
6. Glue

Paint the pinecone with colors of your choice. Cut out a beak and mouth out of felt. Glue pom, eyes, beak and mouth to the top of the pinecone.

Use to decorate your Thanksgiving Table!

# Candle Holders



## Supplies

1. Glass Jar (yogurt jars work great)
2. Fake leaves
3. Paint Brush
4. Modge Podge
5. Battery votive

Paint the back of the leaves with the Modge podge to make them stick to the jar. Place as many as you like. Then put an extra coat of modge podge over the top of all the leaves. A generous amout may be needed to stick them down. Let dry overnight.

Place candle inside for a table decoration.

# Cork Turkey



## Supplies

1. Corks
2. Felt
3. Eyes
4. Colored Paper
5. Glue

Cut out feathers from the colored paper of your choice. Cut out a beak from the felt. Glue feathers, beak and eyes to the cork.

Can be used to decorate for fall or as place settings on your Thanksgiving Table.

# Thanksgiving Hands



## Supplies

1. Foam Sheets
2. Your Hand
3. Scissors
4. Glue gun/Glue
5. Stickers

Trace your hands on the foam sheets. Cut them out, make sure to do one of each hand. Glue the very tops together after you decorate them how you wish. Use them to decorate your Thanksgiving table.
