

GATHERING LOCATION

Henley-in-Arden School is located less than 4 miles from the M40, on the A3400 to Stratford. After the crossroads in Henley-in-Arden, take the first left turn and the school is at the end of this road.



TO REACH US FROM THE M40:

- Southbound M40 from Birmingham, exit at J16. Turn right onto A3400 for Henley-in-Arden.
- Northbound M40, exit at J15 (because J16 has no northbound exit!) and follow Stratford A46. At the next roundabout, take B4463 for Henley-in-Arden and Norton Lindsey. After about 1 mile, turn left onto A4189 to Henley-in-Arden. Follow A4189 for 6 miles to the crossroads in Henley-in-Arden, then turn left onto A3400.

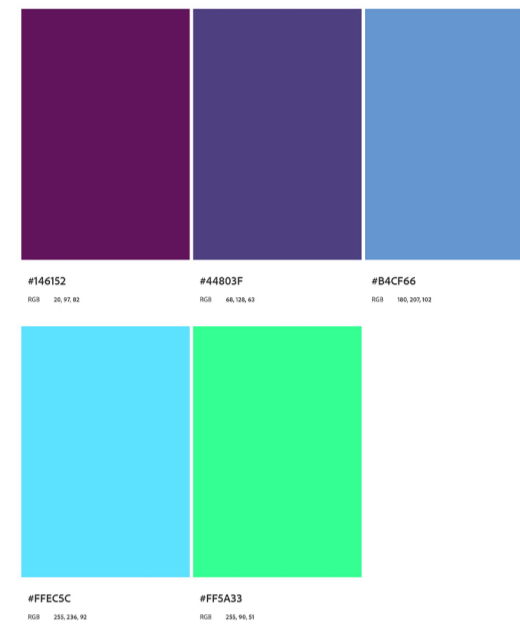
