What You'll Need

- 1. Buy & complete the TEFL course.
- 2. Collect a hard copy of your TEFL Certificate.
- 3. Update your CV by including your TEFL certification.
- 4. Prepare a one-minute introduction video as outlined on the resources page.
- 5. Submit your application along with your CV, degree, TEFL certificate, and an introductory video.
- 6. Arrange an interview with an agent or recruiter.



YOU GOT THE JOB! Now What?

- 7. Contract: Carefully review the contract to understand details like salary, benefits, housing arrangements (if provided), teaching hours, and any additional clauses. Ask if they will provide accommodation on arrival. Compare benefits here.
- 8. Police clearance required from home country, should be issued within six months.







- 9. Authenticate your certificates (Degree, TEFL & Police Clearance) by the appropriate government authorities in your home country.
- 10. Submit the authenticated documents to the relevant Embassy for legalisation. This process typically involves getting an apostille on the document.
- 11. Apply for a (3-month business) visa by submitting authenticated, legalized & translated documents, a passport copy, and a work invitation letter through your school or recruiter.
