What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information for student education and assessment:

- Names for students/children
- Date of birth
- Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) or additional support information (includes reasonable adjustments and special educational needs and disabilities)

Lawful bases and data protection rights

Under UK data protection law, we must have a "lawful basis" for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible <u>lawful</u>

<u>bases</u> in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO's website.

Which lawful basis we rely on may affect your data protection rights which are set out in brief below. You can find out more about your data protection rights and the exemptions which may apply on the ICO's website:

- Your right of access You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. You can request other information such as details about where we get personal information from and who we share personal information with. There are some exemptions which means you may not receive all the information you ask for.

- Your right to rectification You have the right to ask us to correct or delete personal information you think is inaccurate or incomplete. You can read more about this right here.
- **Your right to erasure** You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information. <u>You can read more about this right here</u>.
- Your right to restriction of processing You have the right to ask us to limit how we can use your personal information. You can read more about this right here.
- Your right to object to processing You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. You can read more about this right here.
- Your right to data portability You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you. You can read more about this right here.

If you make a request, we must respond to you without undue delay and in any event within one month.

Our lawful bases for the collection and use of your data

Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information **for student education and assessment** are:

- Consent we have permission from you after we gave you all the relevant information. All of your data protection rights may apply, except the right to object. To be clear, you do have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
- Contract we have to collect or use the information so we can enter into or carry out a contract with you. All of your data protection rights may apply except the right to object.

Where we get personal information from

- · Directly from you
- Parents or carers
- Other education establishments
- Schools

How long we keep information

If the contract is completed electronically personal information is kept for 1 week after the contract is completed (Assessment data has been completed and forwarded to the relevant person/body). After this point all documentation containing personal information is deleted. If the contract is completed on site, required paperwork is completed on site and handed over to the relevant member of staff. No copies of student data or information completed are taken from the school site. All assessment papers used that have personal information on them (student name and DOB) will be securely shredded within 24 hours of the testing.

Who we share information with

Others we share personal information with

- Parents and carers (if permission is given by student)
- Schools

- Pupil Referral Units (PRU's) or Education Otherwise at School Centres (EOTAS)
- Examination boards and bodies

How to complain
