



## Conditions for accepting materials for recycling

### Prohibited Items

The items listed below will be systematically refused. They will be returned to the sender and/or invoiced to cover immobilization and recovery costs.



#### Batteries and lithium-ion batteries

We charge a flat fee of €3,000 per battery.



#### Fireproof and burglar-proof safes



#### Small hazardous waste



#### Uncleaned engines



#### Ammunition and explosives



#### Uncleaned transformers

Only transformers that are PCB-free and accompanied by a cleaning certificate are permitted.



#### Storage batteries

Storage batteries may be brought in, provided they are strictly separated from the rest (e.g., lead batteries).



#### WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment)



#### ELVs (End-of-Life Vehicles)

### Prohibited containers

The following containers are not accepted. They will be returned and/or invoiced to cover immobilization and recovery costs.



#### Small containers with caps (bottles and gas cylinders)

The only exception is if the cap has been removed and the container has been pierced to a depth of at least 2 cm.



#### Large uncleaned containers (tanks and drums)

### Prohibited materials

The following materials are prohibited. They will be returned and/or invoiced to cover immobilization and recovery costs.



#### Asbestos and materials containing asbestos

Asbestos and materials containing asbestos will be returned.



#### Materials containing mercury



#### Radioactive materials

Strictly prohibited in accordance with AFCN regulations. The supplier is responsible for organizing the return and/or invoicing the costs associated with immobilization, storage, and disposal.
