## Ancient Indian Ethos and the World or Planetary Consciousness:

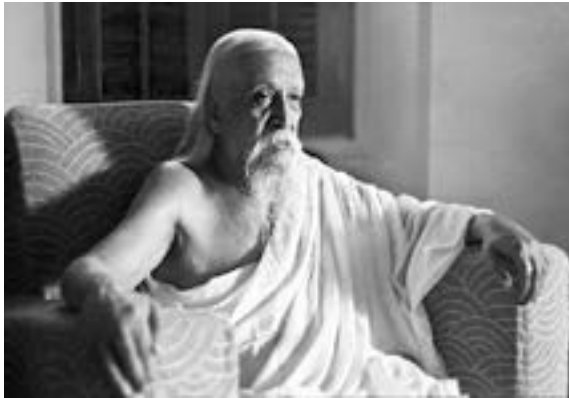
India is the only ancient civilization that considered the World as One Family- “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam” (Maha Upanishad. VI.71-73). Plurality and inclusiveness are unique features of the Indian ethos. Krinvanto Vishvamyam means “Make the World Noble” is the message of Rigveda (9.63.5), which indicates the intention of making the world a better place to live in. Imagine these are the words of the Indian minds, who did not cross their peripheral boundaries, knew very well that there existed lives and minds beyond, never wanted to conquer others’ land. Their firm belief of “तेन त्यक्तेन भुञ्जीथा” Tena Tyaktena Bhunjeetha (Isha Upanishad 1.1)- Consume only what you need (With the understanding that others too have the same needs) and “मा गृधः कस्यस्विद्धनम् ॥ Ma gridaah kasyasvidhanam”-lust not after others’ possessions. And what is the way to make a living, it is said “कुर्वन्नेवेह कर्माणि जिजीविषेत् शतं समाः-kurvanneveha karmāNi jijīviṣet śatam samāh “one should live a hundred years doing the verily the works. So the society shunned inactivity and inertia.”संगच्छध्वं संवदध्वं सं वो मनांसि जानताम्sangacchadhvam samvadadhvam sam vo manānsi jānatām” - May we move in harmony, speak in one voice; let our minds be in agreement is again the voice of Rigveda, where the conversation is between the teacher and the student and interestingly we find “Sam”-us (ie. you and me) together. “समानी व आकूतिः समाना हृदयानि वः ।समानमस्तु वो मनो यथा वः सुसहासति ॥ samanī va ākūtiḥ samānā hrdayāni vah |samānamastu vo

mano yathā vah susahāsati” which again means -May our intentions and aspirations be alike, so that a common objective unifies us all.

Another interesting factor to observe is the consciousness levels of ancient India. They believed that the world is not for only today but for posterity also. Yajurveda says “ॐ द्यौः शान्तिरन्तरिक्षं शान्तिः पृथिवी शान्तिरापः शान्तिरोषधयः शान्तिः ।वनस्पतयः शान्तिर्विश्वेदेवाः शान्तिर्ब्रह्म शान्तिः सर्वं शान्तिः शान्तिरेव शान्तिः सा मा शान्तिरेधि ॥ dyauh śāntir antarikshah śāntih prthivī śāntir āpah śāntir oshadhyah śāntih, vanaspatayah śāntir viśvedevāh śāntir brahma śāntih, sarvah śāntih śāntir eva śāntih sā mā śāntir edhi. (Yaju 36:17) -which means May peace radiate there in the whole sky as well as in the vast ethereal space everywhere. May peace reign all over this earth, in water and in all herbs, trees and creepers. May peace flow over the whole universe. May peace be in the Whole Universe. And may there always exist in all peace and peace alone. Here “shantih” does not mean only peace, it also means welfare, prosperity, growth, progress etc.

Another interesting point in all these is these are not the words are not ascribed to any one individual and hence eternal. These were never transmitted in written form, but were memorized, recited more often so that the meaning and essence should sink into the minds and hearts and not remain on lips. The society was most flexible in allowing alternative thoughts to blossom but had to be based on the fundamentals. Thus, the whole geographic area of vast India, though had many diverse living styles, were intrinsically one at their fundamentals.

## World Federation Envisioned by Sri Aurobindo



Sri Aurobindo, in his message on 15th Aug 1947, mentioned his five dreams. Of them, the third dream is “**World Federation**”. In his own words, “The third dream was a world-union forming the outer basis of a fairer, brighter and nobler life for all mankind. That unification of the human world is underway; there is an imperfect initiation organised, but struggling against tremendous difficulties. But the momentum is there, and it must inevitably increase and conquer. Here too **India has begun to play a prominent part** and, if she can develop that larger statesmanship which is not limited by the present facts and immediate possibilities but looks into the future and brings it nearer, her presence may make all the difference between a slow and timid and a bold and swift development.” He not only said world federation is inevitable, also prophesied that India will play a leading role.

## History of the World Federation Movement

The Campaign for World Government was founded by the Hungarian pacifist Rosika

Schwimmer and her friend and fellow veteran of World War I peace mediation efforts, Lola Maverick Lloyd. In 1937, disenchanted with the League of Nations and its perceived weaknesses, they announced the Campaign’s mission to promote a federal world government directly representing the interests of the world’s people, as opposed to the interests of states. While the specific methods promoted for achieving this goal shifted over the next several decades, the Campaign adhered to the concept of a populist global federalism throughout its existence.

## India At the United Nations in 1945

Having world peace at heart, India has been part of all major global peace initiatives. India was signatory to “The Peace Treaty of Versailles, signed June 28, 1919” and thus one of the original members of the League of Nations. After the failure of all their earlier efforts to secure the peace in the world, one more attempt was made at the San Francisco Conference in 1945 and a new global organisation emerged in the form of the United Nations.

Interestingly again, India was invited to

participate, and the Indian delegation was lead by Sir Arcot Ramaswamy Mudaliar. He was the first President of the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC). In his concluding remarks at the UN, Sir Mudaliar made a very important statement which is as below.

“Mr. President. There is only one last word that I should like to say. I said that I shall go back an enthusiastic supporter of the Charter that emerges from this conference, whatever defects I might have considered it to have at several stages of our deliberations. I go back in the belief that the time has come and will soon come when the drums of battle will cease to beat, when the battle flags of nations will cease to be unfold. I go back with the hope, maybe the assurance, that here at San Francisco we have taken a step, we have made a move; we have advanced; and that sooner or later, perhaps sooner rather than later, there will be that far-off Divine Event to which the whole creation moves: **the convocation of the Parliament of man, the establishment of the Federation of the World.**”

India was not an independent nation then. Mr. Molotov, the leader of the then Soviet Union, made a prophetic statement which is as follows: “...We have at this Conference an Indian Delegation. But India is not an independant state. **We all know that the time will come when the voice of an independant India will be heard, too.** Nevertheless, we share the view held by the British Government, which suggested that representatives of India should be granted a seat at this Conference, imperfect though her status is....”. We see that now the time

has come when India can lead this global movement.

## BRIEF HISTORY OF WCPA

The World Constitution and Parliament Association (WCPA) emerged from the Campaign for World Government (CWG), a movement that gained momentum in the aftermath of World War II. Recognizing the urgent need for a comprehensive constitution to safeguard the planet, Philip and Margaret Isely, based in Denver, Colorado, USA became key figures in the push for a world parliament and global law. In the mid-1950s, they joined the CWG and in 1958, alongside other individuals, formed the “World Committee for a World Constitutional Convention.” In 1961, the committee relocated to Denver and issued a public call for the convention, garnering committed delegates from 50 nations and endorsements from several heads of state.

In 1966, the organization was renamed the World Constitution and Parliament Association (WCPA), with Philip Isely serving as Secretary-General and Margaret Isely as Treasurer. s Dr. T. P. Amerasinghe of

Sri Lanka and Dr. Reinhart Ruge of Mexico contributed to the growth and development of WCPA. Together, they dedicated their efforts to advancing the cause of a world constitution in their respective roles for many years. Prof. Philip Isely left WCPA in 2003, with Prof. Glen T. Martin assuming the role of Secretary-General.

WCPA, being the promoter of the Constitution, is striving for creation of a democratic Earth Federation under the Constitution for the Federation of the Earth.

**Since 1958**, the organization has worked through its worldwide membership to write and ratify the Earth Constitution, in four international Constituent Assemblies. Under the authority of Article 19 of the Earth Constitution the WCPA has also sponsored 12 sessions of the Provisional World Parliament to date, building a new world order of freedom, justice, prosperity, and equality within the shell of the old, unjust world order. Below is a summary history of our work.

**1958.** Agreement to Call a World Constitutional Convention initiated by four persons, circulated worldwide for signatures, requesting both national governments and the people of each country to send delegates.

**1959-1960.** The World Committee for a World Constitutional Convention formed. Thousands sign the Agreement, including many prominent leaders. Organizers of this action travel around the world to enlist support.

**1961-1962.** Definitive Call to the World Constitutional Convention adopted. Many persons signed, including the Heads of five national governments.

**1963-1964.** First Preparatory Congress held in Denver, Colorado, USA, with delegates from five continents. A Call to the World Constitutional Convention is publicly issued, then circulated for more signers and responses.

**1965-1966.** Second Preparatory Congress held at Milan, Italy. Outline for Debate and Drafting of a World Constitution is formulated on basis of alternative choices. A Plan was agreed for a People's World Parliament to meet concurrently.

**1967.** Decision made at Third Preparatory Congress to begin Convention in 1968, even if no government sends delegates. 300 People's Delegates pledged.

**1968.** First working sessions of World Constitutional Convention and Peoples' World Convention held at Interlaken, Switzerland, and Wolfach, W. Germany, with 200 Peoples Delegates from 27 countries, of five continents. Work begun on drafting the World Constitution.

The delegates elected a drafting committee of 25 persons, which included a prominent Indian Mr. Godey Murahari, former Deputy Chairperson of Rajya Sabha. In 1972

**1969-1971.** The Strategy for Reclaiming Earth for Humanity is circulated. Emergency Council of World Trustees meets, Santa Barbara, Calif., and issues First Decree for Protection of Life, outlawing nuclear weapons. Directions given to the drafting commission.

**1972.** World Constitution drafting commission of four persons, with a fifth communicating by telephone, works for two months, nearly completing the first draft of Constitution for the Federation of Earth.

**1973-1975.** First draft finished, printed in 1974, then circulated worldwide for comment, together with Call to the second session in 1977, now defined as the World Constituent Assembly. Comments on the first draft compiled.

**1976.** Drafting Commission meets again. Second draft completed, circulated,

**1977.** Second Session of World Constituent Assembly held in June, Innsbruck, Austria. Earth Constitution debated paragraph by paragraph, amended, then adopted with

138 original signers from 25 countries of 6 continents. Call for ratification by the

the nations and peoples of Earth are issued. The Constitution is sent to the U.N. General Assembly and all national governments.

**1978-1980.** The Earth Constitution is circulated worldwide for debate and ratification. The third session of the World Constituent Assembly, held in January, 1979, Colombo, Sri Lanka, adopts Rationale For a World Constituent Assembly, defining the right of people to convene the Assembly, draft a constitution, and obtain ratification. Appeal issued for national parliaments to ratify.

**1981.** World Constitution & Parliament Assn. meets at New Delhi, India. Call issued for Provisional World Parliament to convene in 1982 under the terms of Article 19 of the Earth Constitution. Honorary Sponsor list of 150 prominent persons enrolled.

**1982.** First Session of Provisional World Parliament meets at Brighton, England. Delegates from 25 countries of 6 continents. Five world Legislative Acts are adopted: for the World Disarmament Agency, World Economic Development, Ownership of

Oceans & Sea beds, the Graduate School of World Problems, and World Courts.

**1983-1984.** First Provisional District World Court organized in Los Angeles; takes up the case of outlawing nuclear weapons. Plans for Provisional World Parliament in Sudan and Nigeria thwarted by military coups.

**1985.** Second Session of Provisional World Parliament held New Delhi, India. Opened by President of India, presided by the Speaker of Lok Sabha. Three more World Legislative Acts adopted: for Emergency Earth Rescue Administration, World Government Funding, and Commission on Terrorism.

**1986.** Campaign continued for “provisional” ratification of the Constitution for the Federation of Earth, pending review at the next World Constituent Assembly.

**1987.** The third session of Provisional World Parliament held at Hilton Fontainebleau Hotel, Miami Beach, Florida. Three more World Legislative Acts are adopted: for the Global Finance System, Environmental Protection, and Hydrogen Energy. Provisional World Cabinet began.

**1988-1989.** A Plan launched for collaboration by many organizations to prepare next session of World Constituent Assembly. 150 organizations join in Preparatory Committee. Two meetings held in New York with U. N. Ambassadors, to explain and solicit help. List of Honorary Sponsors reconfirmed and expanded.

**1990.** The Government of Egypt agrees to host Assembly. Three preparatory meetings held. A Call was circulated for Governments and People to send delegates.

**1991.** Location of the 4th session World Constituent Assembly abruptly changed due to the 1991 Gulf War. Held at Troia, Portugal, in May. Delegates adopted 59 minor amendments to the Earth Constitution. A new ratification campaign began, appealing to both people and governments. Most Honorary Sponsors personally ratify.

**1992.** Global Ratification & Elections Network was organized, including several hundred organizations, to promote ratification of the Constitution for the Federation of Earth, then an election of delegates to World Parliament. Government heads should also ratify.

**1996.** The Fourth Session of the Provisional World Parliament held at Barcelona, Spain in September. A number of resolutions were passed, as well as a “Manifesto” declaring the oceans the property of the people of Earth under the authority of the Earth Constitution.

**2000.** The Fifth Session of the Provisional World Parliament is held on the Island of Malta, from November 22nd to 27th. One Omnibus legislative act and a number of resolutions were passed, including a resolution strongly supporting the rights of the Palestinian people to their own state.

**2003-March.** The Sixth Session of the Provisional World Parliament was held in

Bangkok, Thailand, from March 23rd to 28th. Several important legislative acts were passed: a World Peace Act, a World Security Act, a Provisional Office of World Revenue Act, a Hydrocarbon Resource Act, and a Statute for the World Court on Human Rights. The Commission for Legislative Review is formed. Parliamentary law format commences with the Sixth Session. The Institute on World Problems (IOWP) is formed as a 501C3 non-profit organization in the US.

**2003-December.** The Seventh Session of the Provisional World Parliament is held at Chennai, India, from December 23-29. Several important legislative acts were passed: a Criminal Penalty Code, Rules for Procedure and Evidence, a World Bench for Criminal Cases Act, a World Patents Act, a Global Accounting and Auditing Standards Act, and a Preservation of World Government Records Act. The Manifesto of the Earth Federation and the “Pledge of Allegiance to the Earth Constitution” (included in this Appendix) were unanimously ratified by the Parliament.

**2004.** The Eighth Session of the Provisional World Parliament was held at Lucknow, India, in August. Several important legislative acts passed, including the creation of a World Bench for Juvenile Cases, a Child Rights Act, an Elections Act, and a Water Act. The International Criminal Court in the Hague is empowered by world legislation. A global Education Act is passed, as well as a World Economic Equity Act establishing the Earth Currency on an independent and fully democratic basis. A Global People’s Assembly is created

to activate grassroots participation in the House of Peoples. The “Declaration on the Rights of Peoples” (included in this volume) was unanimously ratified.

**2006.** The Ninth Session of the Provisional World Parliament was held in Tripoli, Libya, in April. Eight World Legislative Acts are passed, an enabling act for the World Ombudsmus, the creation of a Department of Conflict Resolution for the Earth Federation, a ban on the production of fissile materials for weapons, a nuclear weapons elimination protocol, a nuclear contamination act prohibiting the use of depleted uranium and other weapons, a quit Guantanamo directive, an agreement on world privileges and immunities (revising the weaker version of the Assembly of States Parties, and a public utilities act. The former “Global Ratification and Elections Network (GREN)” is transformed into the Earth Federation Movement (EFM).

**2007.** The Tenth Session of the Provisional World Parliament was held in Kara, Togo, in June. Four world legislative acts are passed: an act prohibiting unauthorized destruction of illegal financial instruments, an act creating a system of divestment from illegal weapons manufacture, an act requiring posting of the world illegal stock law in stock exchanges around the world, and an act providing a guaranteed annual income for all adults within the Earth Federation.

**2008.** The 50th Anniversary Celebrations of the founding of WCPA were hosted by Dr. Phichai Tovivich and the WCPA Chapter of Thailand.



**2009.** The Eleventh Session of the Provisional World Parliament held in Nainital, India, July 2-8, 2009. Several world legislative acts were passed into provisional world law, including a procedure for the dismantling of nuclear weapons, a law protecting the people of Earth from too much bureaucracy in the world government, an act criminalizing human trafficking for sexual or other purposes, an act abolishing all secret intelligence agencies like the CIA, M5 or Mossad, a bill elaborating the restrictions on the military uses of depleted uranium, and a law protecting the right of civil disobedience for the people of Earth under the Earth Federation (included in this volume). The delegation from Bangladesh presented the parliament with a new translation of the Constitution into its 23rd language: Bengali or Bangla.

**2010.** June 1-11, IOWP officers participate in the General Review Conference of the International Criminal Court in Kampala, Uganda, with proposals to link the court with the Earth Constitution. The Twelfth Session of the Parliament held in Kolkata, India, December 27-31, 2010. World Legislative Acts passed for funding the decommissioning of nuclear weapons, abolishing legal corporate personhood, establishing a Collegium of World Judges, establishing a Ship breaking code, creating global economic prosperity, and amending some earlier acts of the Parliament. Resolutions were passed allowing states, cantons, or Pradesh to join the Earth Federation independently, enumerating citizen and governmental responsibilities under the Earth Federation, and modeling

the world peace system created by the Earth Constitution.

### **WCPA India:**

WCPA India took its form on 16th October 1977 at its first meeting held at 11:00 A.M. in the conference hall of the Y.M.C.A youth hostel, New Delhi, when twenty-six persons were present.

Shri Puran Singh Azad, the convener of the India branch, proposed Shri A. B. Patel, the co-president of the World Constitution and Parliament Association, to preside over the meeting. This was seconded by Shri J. C. Bhardwaj, and Shri Patel took the chair. Shri Azad said it was a matter of great

pleasure that the preliminary meeting of the India branch was held under the chairmanship of Shri A. B. Patel, who happens to be the association's co-president.

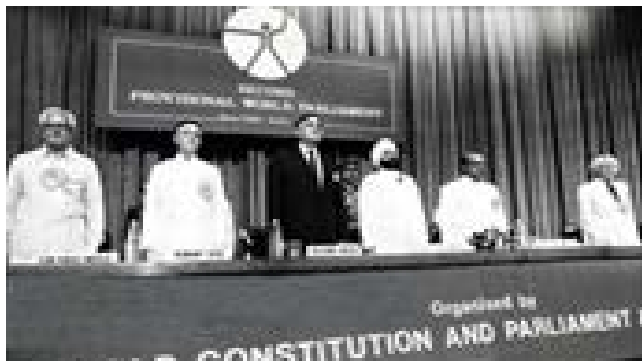
India has been actively involved in the “**Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam**” (World is One Family) movement and has hosted many events across the country.

Sri A B Patel, Prof Philip Isely and Sir. Reinhart Ruge and Mr. T P Amerasinghe played important role in building the movement globally and established a sound base in India.

The Second Provisional World Parliament was held in Delhi in 1985, the event was organised by Sri S P Mittal, Member of Parliament from Rajya Sabha. The event was Inaugurated by the then President of India Sri Giani Zail Singh and presided over by the then Speaker of Lok Sabha Sri Balram Jakhar.

In his inaugural address Giani Zail Singh said "The interdependence of nations is a basic fact of our times and international cooperation must be accepted as a necessity." He also appreciated WCPA's efforts in bringing out the Earth Constitution.



WCPA officials also met the President the Hon. President Giani Zail Singh and



the Prime Minister Sri Rajiv Gandhi and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. Justice Y.V Chandrachud and apprised the efforts.



Justice Y V Chandrachud appreciated with his words "I approve the aims and purposes of the Provisional World Parliament and agree to serve as a Honorary Sponsor. The Provisional World Parliament must become a focal point for the radiation of peace, goodwill and humanity all over the world. The peoples of the world must marshal their strength and courage to halt

the nuclear race. The alternative is the destruction of humanity”.

The people's movement for a democratic global governance or “World Parliament” has not materialised even after 80 years of formation of the UN and the promise made to the world has remained unfulfilled. WCPA has been promoting and hosting



the Provisional World Parliament (PWP) sessions worldwide and 15th sessions session was held during December 2021. In view of the prevailing pandemic restrictions the event was held on hybrid mode in which hundreds of delegates from all over the world could participate in the event. Maj. Sushil Goel, then Vice President (India) organised the session.

### **World Government Indian Parliamentary Group**

A meeting of MPs presided over by the Deputy Speaker of the Lok Sabha, Sri Godey Murahari, decided to form a group in Parliament to support the movement for the World Government. The meeting decided to support in-principle the draft

Constitution for the Federation of the Earth.

### **Private Member's Bill in Indian Parliament**

India has been a front runner in this movement. Many of WCPA office bearers and also prominent promoters in the past were parliamentarians. These members irrespective of their political affiliation worked together. Sri H V Kamath, a Member of Parliament introduced a Private Member Bill on 20th April 1978 and was discussed. Sri Godey Murahari (Congress) was a member of the drafting committee of the Constitution for the Federation of Earth and vehemently supported it in the Indian Parliament. Even World Constitution and Parliament Association, the organisation promoting the Earth Constitution was mentioned in the discussions.

Since it could not be taken up for voting in-time, the bill technically lapsed and a fresh attempt needs to be made to ensure the wishes of Indian citizens is continued.

WCPA India is spearheading the movement from India, with WCPA Board deciding to establish the Secretariat of the World Parliament in India. Various projects like

**a. World Districts Project:** to identify and promote 1000 World Districts from all over the world to support the movement is in progress. India will be contributing around 179 WDs as per 2011 population census data.

**b. World Commissions:** The following 12 Preparatory World Commissions are in operation as constituted under Art.19.1.2

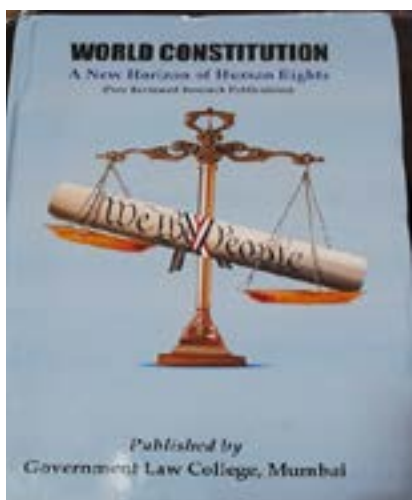

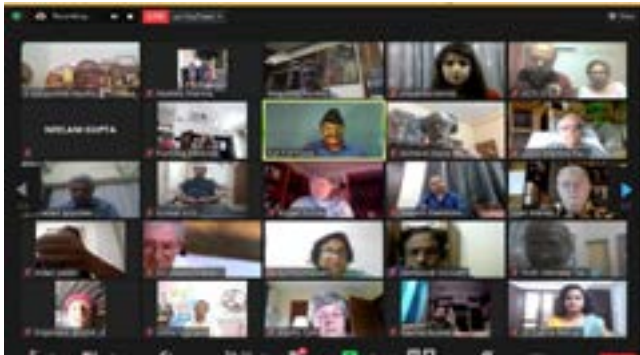

नहीं सकती है, यदि मानव जाति की कचाना है तो एक बल्ड फौडरल गवर्नमेंट (महासंघीय सरकार) का निर्माण करना होगा। यदि ऐसी बल्ड गवर्नमेंट को हम लायें, तो उस के लिए एक कॉन्स्टीट्यूट एसेम्बली का निर्माण कर के उस का पूरा कॉन्स्टीट्यूशन बनाना होगा।

उपाध्यक्ष महोदय, अब वक्त आ गया है जब कि हम को इस पर सीरियसली विचार करना चाहिये। आप इस बात को जानते हैं कि आप ने स्वयं इस धिल के लिए बहुत कुछ काम किया है। इस सिलसिले में एक बहुत बड़ी संस्था है—“बल्ड कॉन्स्टीट्यूशन एण्ड पालियामेंट”। उस संस्था की तरफ से “इजडुक” पत्रिका में दुनिया के लगभग 150 राष्ट्रों के पब्लिक रिप्रेजेंटेटिव गये थे। अभी 6 महीने पहले उन लोगों ने वहाँ पर इकट्ठा हो कर बल्ड-कॉन्स्टीट्यूशन तैयार किया, जिस के हर घास्पेक्ट पर वहाँ चर्चा हुई। किस तरह से पूरे बल्ड की फौडरल गवर्नमेंट को बनाना चाहिए, इस के बारे में विचार-विमर्श के बाद एक संविधान का निर्माण किया गया और उसकी एक नींव रखी गई है। तो आज हम को उस को रेटीफाई करने का वक्त आ गया है। बेस्ट जर्मनी, अमेरिका और केनाडा के अन्दर बहुत सारी नगर-पालिकाओं ने और बहुत सारी नेशन ने उसको रेटीफाई किया है। उस कॉन्स्टीट्यूशन को जो दुनिया के सब राष्ट्रों की जनता के प्रतिनिधियों ने हँठ कर पास किया है, उस को बहुत ही ज्यादा सीरियसली ले कर हम को विचार करना पड़ेगा और अगर यह पालियामेंट यह तय करती है, अगर भारतीय पालियामेंट यह निश्चय करती है कि बल्ड की एक कॉन्स्टीट्यूट एसेम्बली हो और उस के अन्दर विचार-विमर्श हो, तो यह एक बहुत बड़ी बात होगी और हम दुनिया को एक रास्ता दिखा सकते हैं। बहुत सारी नेशन इस के लिए बहुत ज्यादा सीरियस नहीं हैं और भारत ही

एक ऐसा राष्ट्र है जो इस के लिए कदम बढ़ा कर, इनिशिएटिव ले कर दुनिया को रास्ता दिखा सकता है। जब हम पालियामेंट के सेन्ट्रल हॉल में चुनते हैं तो वह निश्चय पाते हैं :

अथ निजः परोक्षेति गणना लघुचेतसाम् ।  
उदारचरितानां तु वसुधैव कुटुम्बकम् ॥

यह जो हमारा मॉडेल है, यह जो हमारा उद्देश्य है, यह इस से ही पूरा हो सकता है और यह मंजूर अगर कोई वे सकता है तो भारत ही वे सकता है और भारत ही इस काम को कर सकता है। इसलिए मैं वहाँ अपने मित्रों से अपील करूँगा कि वे इस का समर्थन करें क्योंकि हमें सा से हम शांति का स्वोगन ले कर चले हैं और शांति के लिए जितने प्रयत्न भारत की तरफ से हुए हैं आज तक दुनिया में किसी राष्ट्र ने नहीं किये हैं। जब ऐसे प्रयत्न भारत करता है तो बल्ड की एक कॉन्स्टीट्यूट एसेम्बली हो और उस के अन्दर एक बल्ड कॉन्स्टीट्यूशन बनाया जाए और एक बल्ड की फौडरल गवर्नमेंट की नींव रखी जाए। अगर ऐसा होता है तो मैं समझता हूँ कि हिन्दुस्तान में ही नहीं बल्कि सारे विश्व में एक ऐसा रिश्ता रहेगा और विश्व को हम यह बता सकेंगे कि अहिंसुनि लोग हिन्दुस्तान में विश्व शांति के लिए प्रयत्न करते रहे हैं और करते रहेंगे। मैं समझता हूँ कि इस से अधिक अच्छा और कोई दूसरा काम नहीं हो सकता है। इस दृष्टि से माननीय सदस्य इस चीज को देखें। हमारे जो उपाध्यक्ष महोदय हैं, वे बल्ड कॉन्स्टीट्यूशन एण्ड पालियामेंटरी एसोसिएशन के सेयरर्सन रह चुके हैं और कई जगहों पर गए हैं और मैं उन के साथ रहा हूँ और मैं गंभीर अनुभव करता हूँ कि ऐसे महान् व्यक्ति इस चीज में हमें मदद देते रहे हैं। लोग इस चीज का ज्यादा उदास सकते हैं लेकिन एक दिन ऐसा आएगा जब यह तथ्य वास्तविकता बन कर रहेगा। पाकिस्तान की जब बात उठी थी, तो वह एक ड्रीम सी लगती थी लेकिन वह
