From the Daily Devotional Book "God's Purpose for Your Life" by Charles Stanley

PAY ATTENTION

We must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away for it.

Hebrews 2:1

T oday , your anchor is within reach. The ability to endure everything that assails you is within your ability to grasp it. You may feel as if you're drifting toward the edge of the abyss—so much is failing, unsure, unknown, and out of control. But hope is within reach. So how do you take hold of it?

Today's verse tells you how: pay close attention to what you've heard from God. Fix your eyes on Him. Remember that no matter how everything might look at the moment, it does not reveal the full story or take in to account everything that's really going on. For example, Hebrews was written to Jewish Christians who were being persecuted. However, God worked through the persecution to scatter those early believers throughout the Roman Empire. This resulted in the gospel spreading like wildfire throughout the realm. What looked like a terrible situation was actually part of the Lord's great plan to save multitudes.

The same is true for your situation. God is always in control and always has purpose. But taking hold of what Jesus has for you requires devotion. So don't allow the drift to dis hearten you. Pay attention to the Lord and grab hold of hope.
