#### LISTEN CLOSELY

Pray without ceasing.

1 Thessalonians 5:17

Sometimes it can be difficult to hear God when so many other voices clamor for your attention. But you can train yourself to listen to the Lord in any circumstance. You always have the ability to think about Him, meditate on His Word, and receive His counsel no matter what is happening.

#### Did you know?

The church has processes in place to request funds for college scholarships or to assist with paying for vocational, trade school or other types of life enrichment opportunities. In the past, a number of Scholarships were awarded to eligible church members and Life Enrichment funds were provided to all ages of members and friends for various types of trade schools

**Scholarship** applications require you to be a Westminster Presbyterian member for one year, to have completed 26 college hours at an accredited college and be working toward your first associates or bachelor's degree. Transcripts of completed hours must be submitted with the application.

**Life Enrichment** applications require you to be planning to attend vocational or trade schools or any institution which can enrich your life.

Applications are reviewed and awarded by the Session. Scholarship funds are only issued to the college.

#### Wright Awareness Coaching & **Consulting Workshop**
