Choose any three of these:

- a | Name and identify the main parts of an aeroplane
- b | Identify six airlines from their markings.
- c | Name and identify different types of aircraft
- d | Collect and identify six pictures of different aircraft
- e | Explain how different weather conditions can affect air activities
- f | Fly in an aircraft and tell the rest of your section about it
- g | Meet someone who flies regularly and talk to them about their experiences

Send a simple message using the phonetic alphabet.

This could be an email to leaders when you have completed your requirements, saying that you've completed the badge and want to present it to Cubs.
