Book Reader Activity Badge

How to earn your badge

Make a list of at least six books you have read or used recently. Name the authors of your books.

We've added a sheet where you can list these books.

Show that you know how to care for your books and know the benefits a library can bring to people who enjoy reading.

Make a poster advertising your local library to people, telling them at least three things they can do in a library.

Show that you can use a dictionary and a thesaurus

When you're ready to complete your badge, we'll ask you to describe to your Sixer how to use both a thesaurus and a dictionary. They will need to pretend that they don't know what they are, and you need to guide them in finding a word in the dictionary, then finding a similar word by using an imaginary thesaurus.

Write a review of your favourite book and share it with your Sixer, an Explorer Scout Young Leader or your Cub Leader.

To complete this requirement, write a book review (it doesn't have to be too long, just a page) and share with your leaders.
