SUBMITTING YOUR MANUSCRIPT

WHETHER YOU ARE A FICTION OR NONFICTION AUTHOR:

Manuscripts submitted should be at least 50% of the story, indicate if they are novels or novella's. They must come with a brief synopsis of the book and the authors bio.

Novels should have a minimum word count of 30,000 words for print copies. Novellas should have a minimum word count of 15,000 words and are for eBook only.

Manuscripts must be written in English, 12 point font, Times Roman Numeral, Aptos, or Calibre.. The chapters headings should be in 20 point font and in bold.

THE SELECTION PROCESS
