**COUNT 1-CRIMINAL MISCHIEF (F6)**

On or about January 10, 2015, Jesse James Morrison, in the course of a single criminal episode, unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly damaged the real or personal property of Tom Cutright, the aggregate damage being one thousand dollars or more but less than five thousand dollars; in violation of section 18-4-501(1),(4)(d), C.R.S.

**COUNT 2-FIRST DEGREE CRIMINAL TRESPASS (F5)**

On or about January 10, 2015, Jesse James Morrison unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly entered the motor vehicle of Tom Cutright with intent to commit therein the crime of Criminal Mischief; in violation of section 18-4-502, C.R.S.

**COUNT 3-AGGRAVATED MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT IN THE FIRST DEGREE (F5)**

On or about January 10, 2015, Jesse James Morrison unlawfully, feloniously, and knowingly obtained or exercised control over the motor vehicle of Tom Cutright, without authorization, or by threat or deception, and caused five hundred dollars or more property damage, including but not limited to property damage to the motor vehicle involved, in the course of obtaining control over or in the exercise of control of the motor vehicle, and the value of the motor vehicle was less than twenty thousand dollars; in violation of section 18-4-409(2),(3)(a), C.R.S.

**COUNT 4-DRIVING UNDER RESTRAINT - ALCOHOL RELATED OFFENSE (M)**

On or about January 10, 2015, Jesse James Morrison unlawfully operated or drove a motor vehicle upon a highway with knowledge that the defendant's license or driving privilege was under restraint, as a result of an alcohol-related conviction or an alcohol-related administrative action; in violation of section 42-2-138(1)(d), C.R.S.



AFFIANT, KEVIN KINGSTON, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

THAT he has probable cause to believe that the person known as JESSE JAMES MORRISON, DOB: 112895, has committed the following criminal offense(s), namely:

1. 18-4-501      Criminal Mischief (over \$1,000)      Class: F4
2. 18-4-502      First Degree Criminal Trespass      Class: F5
3. 18-4-409(2)(b) Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft (over \$1,000)      Class: F6
4. 42-2-138      Drove Under Revocation – Alcohol      Class: M

THAT the facts establishing probable cause, and grounds for issuance of an arrest warrant, are:

1. That your AFFIANT is a duly sworn Deputy Sheriff for the Larimer County Sheriff's Office and is currently assigned to the patrol unit and is responsible for conducting criminal investigations in and for Larimer County.
2. On 011015 at approximately 0521 hours, Deputy ETHAN POWERS of the Larimer County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to a report of a vehicle that was stolen from the address of 807 7th Street, Berthoud, Colorado. Deputy POWERS had report 15-241 assigned for this incident. Deputy POWERS had the vehicle entered into NCIC/CCIC (National Crime Information Center/Colorado Crime Information Center) as stolen.
3. The reported stolen vehicle is a gray 2003 Ford Focus, four-door, with a Vehicle Identification Number of 1FAFP34P43W257331, and bears Illinois license plate R218741. This vehicle was valued at \$2,000. The owner of the vehicle is TOM CUTRIGHT, DOB: 122960, and resides at 807 7th Street, Berthoud, Colorado.
4. On 011015 at approximately 1107 hours, Your AFFIANT located the reported stolen 2003 gray Ford Focus, bearing Illinois license plate R218741 and Vehicle Identification Number 1FAFP34P43W257331. Larimer County Communications confirmed that this vehicle was the same vehicle reported to Deputy POWERS. This vehicle was located in front of the address of 1005 Franklin Avenue in Berthoud, Colorado.
5. You AFFIANT and TOM CUTRIGHT, victim and owner of stolen vehicle, observed the vehicle in front of 1005 Franklin Avenue in Berthoud, Colorado. The front right tire was flat, torn and destroyed. This tire according to TOM CUTRIGHT was a new tire that he had just bought. The cost of the new tire is approximately \$100. The front right rim was scraped, dent and severely damaged and had to be replaced at a cost of approximately \$125. There were multiple small dents in the underneath section of the front right wheel well with an estimated damage cost of \$500. The inside of the vehicle had bleach soaked in the driver's seat, on the dash, on the arm rest and on the gear shift with an estimated damage of \$500. The fan serpentine belt was snapped in half with a replace value of \$20. Total estimated damage is \$1,245.
6. Inside the stolen vehicle on the rear seat was a gray backpack with red zippers. This backpack had stitching with the words "All Around Roustabout" on it. TOM CUTRIGHT stated this was not his backpack. Inside the backpack, Your AFFIANT located a deodorant stick, a pair of socks, a pair of women's panties and two paystubs. The paystubs listed to the name of JESSE J. MORRISON.
7. JESSE JAMES MORRISON, DOB: 112895, was identified as the owner of the gray backpack. This was done through paystubs and law enforcement records showing the same address for JESSE JAMES

MORRISON. MORRISON resides 835 8th Street in Berthoud, Colorado. This address is approximately one block north and one block west of TOM CUTRIGHT's residence where the vehicle was stolen from.

8. You AFFIANT located an arrest warrant for JESSE JAMES MORRISON, DOB: 111895. Your AFFIANT went to JESSE JAMES MORRISON's residence of 835 8th Street and contact JESSE JAMES MORRISON there. Your AFFIANT arrested JESSE JAMES MORRISON for the active warrant.

9. JESSE JAMES MORRISON was brought to the Larimer County Sheriff's Office Berthoud Substation located at 328 Massachusetts Avenue in Berthoud, Colorado, on this warrant charge only. JESSE JAMES MORRISON was unhandcuffed and he stated that he knew he under arrest for the warrant and the warrant only.

10. JESSE JAMES MORRISON identified the gray backpack that was found in the back seat of the stolen vehicle as being his. JESSE JAMES MORRISON observed this backpack in the back seat of Your AFFIANT's patrol vehicle. JESSE JAMES MORRISON could see this backpack through the plexi-glass that separates the rear seat of Your AFFIANT's patrol vehicle. JESSE JAMES MORRISON openly stated that he knew he had deodorant, his girlfriend's panties and some miscellaneous clothing in the backpack along with his paystubs. JESSE JAMES MORRISON stated to Your AFFIANT that the backpack was stolen in an unreported vehicle trespass. He stated this only after he was told by Your AFFIANT that the backpack was located in the back seat of a stolen vehicle.

11. Upon interview, JESSE JAMES MORRISON stated that he knew nothing of the stolen vehicle. After the interview, MORRISON was again handcuffed and taken to the Larimer County Jail and booked on his warrant.

12. Deputy JUSTIN ATWOOD of the Larimer County Sheriff's Office is an evidence technician. Deputy ATWOOD process the 2003 gray Ford Focus bearing Illinois license plate R218741 with Vehicle Identification Number 1FAFP34P43W257331. Deputy ATWOOD advised he was able to recover a latent thumb print and partial latent prints off of the vehicle. Deputy ATWOOD sent these recovered latent finger prints to the Northern Colorado Regional Forensic Laboratory to be processed.

13. Your AFFIANT spoke with SARA HERGENREDER, who is JESSE MORRISON's mother. SARA HERGENREDER stated she was missing an unopened medium sized bottle of bleach from her residence. SARA HERGENREDER stated to Your AFFIANT that she checked all of her trash cans and was unable to find the unopened medium sized bottle of bleach and no one else inside her residence stated that they had used the bleach.

14. JESSE JAMES MORRISON was interviewed at the Larimer County Jail in regards to his involvement in the stolen vehicle. JESSE JAMES MORRISON, after his Miranda Advisement was issued, stated he wanted to speak to his lawyer. Your AFFIANT did not ask any questions of JESSE JAMES MORRISON after he advised he wanted his lawyer.

15. On 033115, Deputy ATWOOD received confirmation from the Northern Colorado Regional Forensic Laboratory (NCRFL) that the latent finger print, listed in Larimer County Sheriff's Office evidence as JMA-1, and categorized as item 1.1-02 by the NCRFL, as being "identified to the right thumb of record finger prints being the name JESSE JAMES MORRISON (SID: 2622964)". According to a criminal history SID 2622964 belongs to JESSE JAMES MORRISON, DOB: 112895.

16. JESSE JAMES MORRISON, DOB: 112895, with Colorado driver license number [REDACTED] is revoked for an alcohol offense – minor – on Department of Revenue case number 13-353877 from the dates of 010214 through 010115.



#### Results/Opinions and Interpretations:

Two latent fingerprints (1.1-01 and 1.1-02) suitable for comparison were observed on item 1.1.

No latent prints suitable for comparison were observed on item 1.2.

Latents 1.1-01 and 1.1-02 were entered into the state database and candidate lists were generated. Based on these lists, latent 1.1-02 was compared and identified to the right thumb of record fingerprints bearing the name of Jesse James Morrison (SID 2622964).

Latent 1.1-01 was also compared to record fingerprints bearing the name of Jesse James Morrison, with inconclusive results due to the limited correspondence of ridge detail. Latent 1.1-01 was retained in the state database and will continue to search against new records entered into the database. If an identification is made in the future, the submitting agency will be notified.



Vehicle Information

LAURA described the vehicle as a gray 2003 Ford Focus. She stated that it was a four door sedan and that it was missing the gas door. It was also described as having a cracked windshield. LAURA informed me that on the night of 010915 she parked the vehicle, but did not lock the doors. LAURA also informed me that the vehicle had a broken off key in the ignition and that the vehicle could be started by turning the ignition.

Suspect Information

The CUTRIGHTs were unable to provide me with any possible leads on a suspect in this case. They stated that they do not know anyone in town and have not had any problems with neighbors. They also informed me they have not noticed anything suspicious in the area or near their house in the recent past.

I performed a neighborhood canvass of the area, which yielded no results. I was unable to contact anyone in their residences. I attempted to contact residents of three houses which had interior lights on; however; none of the residents answered their door.

I searched the area that the vehicle was parked in and was unable to locate any evidence of the crime or generate any leads in possible suspects.

Vehicle Disposition

The vehicle was entered into NCIC/CCIC (National Crime Information Center/Colorado Crime Information Center) as stolen on 011015.

Case Status: In Suspense

On 011015 at approximately 0922 hours, I responded to 1005 Franklin Avenue, Berthoud at the request of Deputy KEVIN KINGSTON. Deputy KINGSTON was standing by with a reported stolen vehicle and requested my assistance with recovering evidence. I responded to the scene and met with Deputy KINGSTON. I observed the vehicle which was a small grey colored Ford Focus. Inside the vehicle, I observed that there was a very strong odor of bleach coming from the vehicle. I took overall, medium range and close up photographs of the vehicle. I obtained a total of 28 photographs from the vehicle and scene including the physical damage to the front passenger side. I then applied silver fingerprint dust to the exterior of the driver's door and the area around the front hood and passenger fender where the damage was. I collected several latent prints on lift number one from the driver's door. I also was able to locate one latent print on the hood of the vehicle near the passenger side. I also collected DNA swabs of the latent prints on the driver's side door. For my safety, due to the overwhelming strong odor of bleach coming from the inside of the vehicle, I did not enter the vehicle to process the inside of the vehicle. The above evidence was logged at the Larimer County Sheriff's Office and a request was made with the Colorado Bureau of Investigation for processing of the evidence that I collected. Corporal REIFSCHEIDER and I went to the address of 835 8th Street in Berthoud, Colorado, to make contact with Mr. JESSE MORRISON. Upon knocking on the door I was met by Mr. MORRISON's father. I asked him if JESSE was at home. He stated that he was downstairs asleep. I asked Mr. MORRISON if JESSE was home approximately two evenings ago. He stated that he was. I asked him how he knew he was home in the middle of the night. He explained that on 011015 at approximately 0130 in the morning he heard his son JESSE arguing with another friend of his. I asked Mr. MORRISON if his son owned a gray backpack and he stated that he did not believe that he did. Mr. MORRISON then went to the downstairs area of his residence to retrieve JESSE MORRISON.

A male subject who I had already identified through a booking photo appeared out of the kitchen from the downstairs apartment area. This was JESSE MORRISON. I requested Communications to confirm the warrant, which Communications did confirm the warrant. I advised Mr. MORRISON that I was there because he had a warrant and he told me that he already knew he had a warrant. Mr. MORRISON then requested that we go downstairs so he could retrieve his phone. I walked with Mr. MORRISON downstairs. Mr. MORRISON continued to get dressed and grabbed his phone. We had Mr. MORRISON leave his earrings along with any other jewelry and bands at the residence. I did a pat down on Mr. MORRISON and did not locate any items or paraphernalia.

Arrest

I advised Mr. MORRISON that he was under arrest for his felony warrant and he told me that he understood. Mr. MORRISON was taken into custody without incident. His hands were placed behind his back. My handcuffs were placed on his wrists and my index finger fit between the wrist and the handcuff. Mr. MORRISON was then escorted to the backseat of my patrol vehicle where he was secured.

Interview with MORRISON

After removing Mr. MORRISON from his residence I transported him to the Berthoud Town Hall with Corporal REIFSCHEIDER. Once inside my office I un-handcuffed Mr. MORRISON. I had Mr. MORRISON sit down at a table. I advised Mr. MORRISON that he knew he was under arrest for the warrant. He told me that he did. I again advised him that it was for the warrant and the warrant only and he told me that he understood that. Mr. MORRISON asked me how I had his backpack when he observed it in the backseat of my patrol vehicle. I asked Mr. MORRISON how his backpack got inside of a stolen vehicle. Mr. MORRISON explained that his backpack was stolen from his friend's car "a couple days ago." Mr. MORRISON explained that inside his backpack he had multiple clothing items. He explained that he had a pair of skinny jeans along with a jersey and some miscellaneous clothing. He also explained that he had a pay stub that was inside the backpack. I asked Mr. MORRISON why his backpack was in the backseat of a stolen vehicle. Mr. MORRISON stated that he did not know. I explained to Mr. MORRISON that we had located fingerprints on the vehicle. Mr. MORRISON again stated that he knew nothing of the stolen vehicle. Mr. MORRISON was adamant that he did not steal the vehicle and was never inside of the stolen vehicle or anywhere around the stolen vehicle. I asked him if the fingerprints recovered on the vehicle were going to match his and he told me that they would not. I, again, asked Mr. MORRISON why he did not report his backpack being stolen from another friend's car. He told me that he knew he had his warrant and did not want to notify the police because he knew he would be arrested. He also stated that the only thing that was in the backpack was some clothing and that he did not miss that if it was the only thing that was stolen.

I spoke to SARA HERGENREDER, JESSE MORRISON's mother, after I received a telephone call from her. SARA stated that when I was originally at her residence, and arrested her son on his warrant, I had spoken to him about his backpack being found in a stolen vehicle that had bleach inside the vehicle. SARA stated that after I left she checked her bleach and realized that her medium sized, circular, bleach bottle was missing.

She explained that this was a full bottle and that she had checked all of her trash cans and could not locate it. SARA also stated that she had received a phone call from JESSE while he was in jail wanting bail and he made a statement about law enforcement not going to be able to find his fingerprints on the stolen vehicle. SARA also stated that she had noticed a couple of scratch marks or slight abrasions to the left side of her son's neck just prior to me arresting her son. SARA believed that this was from a seat belt and SARA believes that her son did steal the vehicle. SARA also explained that another friend of JESSE's was at the house in the morning of the theft and that this friend is from Milliken and had to be driven to her house. It is unknown who this other friend is at this time.

I asked SARA if she knew if her son had ever had DNA swabs done on him. SARA explained that from another criminal case in Milliken, DNA swabs were done on him. A request will be sent to CBI in an attempt to compare the DNA file that is already on record of JESSE MORRISON to the DNA swabs that were taken by Deputy ATWOOD when he processed the stolen vehicle. I went to the Larimer County Jail to interview JESSE MORRISON. Upon meeting with JESSE in a Jail interview room, I advised him of his Miranda Rights. JESSE immediately stated he wanted his lawyer. No questions were asked by me and no statements were made by JESSE.

On 033115 at 1200 hours, I received a report from the Northern Colorado Regional Forensic Laboratory (NCRFL) regarding this case and specifically to latent prints that I submitted to the NCRFL for identification purposes. The report that I received from the NCRFL had case number assigned by the NCRFL as #N15-241. I observed that Criminologist JULIE FULTON wrote the report that contained the following information. The latent fingerprint evidence was submitted to the NCRFL on 020415, by hand to hand transfer between KRISTI JAUKEN of the Larimer County Sheriff's Office to the NCRFL. The item that was submitted, JMA-1, contained two black latent fingerprint cards with silver dust. The cards were compared to a known victim, TIMOTHY JON CUTRIGHT, DOB: [REDACTED] and did not result in a comparison identification by the NCRFL to CUTRIGHT.

FULTON reported that the fingerprint card JMA-1 Lift #1 had two latent fingerprints that were of value and entered into the AFIS (Automated Fingerprint Identification System). These prints were identified as Latent Lift #1, prints # 1 and 2 or #1.1-01 and #1.1-02 from the victim's driver's side door. Latent lift 1.1-02 or the second fingerprint identified from JMA-1 lift #1 was positively identified as belonging to the right thumb of JESSE JAMES MORRISON, DOB: 112895, State Identification #2622964. This identified print was located on the driver's side door of the stolen vehicle. Latent Lift #1 print #1 did not have enough ridge detail for a print confirmation. Latent Lift card #2, identified as coming from the hood of the vehicle did not have any latent prints of value. Criminologist FULTON completed the analysis report and provided a compact disc to the Larimer County Sheriff's Office as evidence of her findings. Please see the attached report for further information. Deputy KINGSTON was advised of the findings of this evidence in person on 033115 at 1300 hours. No further action by this deputy at this time.
