Weld County Sheriff's Office is in search of a 25-year-old man wanted for kidnapping and second-degree assault.

Jesse James Morrison — whose last known address was in Evans — is wanted for three active warrants. His warrants include a felony warrant for kidnapping and second-degree assault. He also has two bench warrants for misdemeanor charges for not appearing in court for traffic charges.

Morrison is described as a white man, 5'11" tall and weighs around 155 pounds. He has brown eyes and hair and two tattoos. The tattoos are described as a star on his chest and birds surrounding the word "karma" on his right arm, according to a post from the Weld County's Sheriff's office.
