### **Introduction**

Ezekiel’s vision in chapter 47 is more than imagery—it is a divine blueprint. It reveals the flow of God’s presence that heals, revives, and restores. The river is symbolic of the Spirit of God, the Word, and His glory moving from His house into the world.

### **Context of Ezekiel 47**

Israel was in exile. Hope was lost. But God gave Ezekiel a vision of restoration: a renewed temple, divine order, and a supernatural river. This river represents God's life-giving power.

### **Key Insights from Verses 1–12**

- Verses 1–2: River flows from the temple toward the east – a symbol of new beginnings.
- Verses 3–5: The water deepens—ankle, knee, waist, then a river that cannot be crossed.
- Verses 6–9: Everywhere the river goes, life comes.
- Verse 10: Fishermen = Harvesters; nets = apostolic structures.
- Verse 11: Swamps = places that resist the Spirit remain barren.
- Verse 12: Trees = Sons; Leaves = Healing ministries.

### **Five Prophetic Themes**

1. The river = The Holy Spirit and God's presence.
2. Depth = Levels of surrender and maturity.
3. Healing = Individual and territorial.
4. Restoration = Preparation for reformation.
5. Sons = Trees of righteousness sent to heal nations.

### **Apostolic Implications**

- Apostolic Hubs will be formed around God's river.
- Sons will be trained to carry healing and revival.
- God's presence will flow from the Church into the world, transforming it.

### **Reflection & Application**

- What level of the river are you in—ankle, knee, waist, or submerged?
- Where have you resisted God's flow?
- What part of your life needs the healing waters of His presence?
- Are you ready to be a tree that produces fruit and healing for others?
