- Social Security Number (SSN) or ITIN
- Valid government-issued ID
- Previous year's tax return (if applicable)
- Spouse/dependent information (if filing jointly or claiming credits)

#### □ 2. Income Records

- 1099-NEC forms (if working as an independent contractor)
- W-2 forms (if employed by a salon or spa)
- Cash income logs or appointment books
- Credit card/debit sales reports (from Square, Stripe, Clover, etc.)
- Online booking system income reports (Vagaro, Fresha, etc.)
- Tips (cash and electronic) tracked and reported

## ☐ 3. Business Expenses (Deductible)

- Beauty products and supplies (hair color, polish, lashes, skincare, etc.)
- Tools and equipment (scissors, blow dryers, massage beds, etc.)
- Uniforms or professional clothing
- Continuing education, training, and certifications
- Licensing and state board fees
- Booth rental or salon suite rent
- Business insurance
- Marketing & advertising (social media, flyers, Google Ads)
- Software or apps (booking, accounting, CRM tools)
- Website/domain hosting fees
- Phone/internet (portion used for business)
- Travel/mileage for business (e.g. mobile services)
- Office/salon furniture
- Cleaning/sanitation supplies

## ☐ 4. Home Office Deduction (if applicable)

- Square footage of workspace
- Utilities and rent (portion allocated for business use)
- Office supplies

### ☐ 5. Banking & Financial Records

- Business bank statements
- Credit card statements used for business expenses
- Receipts for all business-related purchases
- Digital payment records (Cash App, Venmo, PayPal, Zelle, etc.)
