☐ 3. Business Expenses (Deductible)

- Fuel receipts or fuel card statements
- Truck lease or loan payment records
- Maintenance and repairs
- Insurance premiums (truck/trailer)
- Toll receipts and parking fees
- Trailer lease payments (if applicable)
- ELD subscription or GPS tracking expenses
- IFTA tax payments
- Permits, licenses, and vehicle registration fees
- Load board or dispatch service fees
- Office supplies, phone, internet (if used for business)
- Software or apps used for accounting/logistics
- Professional services (accountant, tax preparer)

☐ 4. Travel-Related Expenses

- Per diem log or actual meal expenses
- Lodging (hotels/motels during trips)
- Protective gear or uniforms

□ 5. Vehicle & Mileage Records

- Odometer readings and total miles driven
- Business vs. personal mileage log
- Vehicle purchase documents (if new truck/trailer was bought)

- Bank statements (especially if using a personal account for business)
- Business credit card statements
- Form **2290** (Heavy Highway Vehicle Use Tax)
