In reference to your inquiry as to whether the Factory are in a position to supply alloy pistons measuring 2-3/4 inches in diameter of the "Slipper" type, we wish to inform you that they are not in a position to supply any other pistoms than those illustrated and listed in our parts catalogue.

We have our own dies in which these pistons are cast and we cannot procure anything different.

We are not familiar with the Apollo high speed magneto, but the Scintilla is a very fine instrument and is used generally on these fast racing cars. It is very expensive and is built by the Scintilla Magneto Co. of Sydney, N. Y., We are now in communication with this concern with a view of obtaining a quatation on the magneto as descended in your letter. We shall revert to this at a later date.
