Empowering Futures: Celebrating the 2023 REEX Jumpstart Summer Programs

We are pleased to present the final report for the 2023 REEX Jumpstart Summer Programs, an embodiment of our unwavering commitment to fostering diversity and excellence in the world of commercial real estate (CRE). This year's achievements have been nothing short of exceptional, and we are honored to share this journey of transformation and empowerment with you.

Continuing the Legacy: Building upon Previous Achievements

Since its inception, the REEX Jumpstart Summer Programs have been on an extraordinary journey, igniting the passion for CRE in young minds. To briefly recap the milestones:

2017: The inaugural program exposed 27 talented high school students to the foundational aspects of CRE through a partnership with NAIOP and Georgia State University.

2018: The program expanded, welcoming 84 diverse high school students across campuses like Columbia, Fordham, Georgia State, and Villanova Universities.

2019: Collaborating with Cornell University, MIT, Roosevelt University, and the University of Miami, the program reached 112 students, solidifying its impact.

2020: Adapting to the virtual landscape, the program's online pivot saw 140 participants, illustrating resilience and growth.

2021: Tripling university partnerships, introducing multiple sessions, and engaging 159 students showcased an evolving commitment to empowerment.

2022: Rebranded as REEX JumpStart, the program returned to in-person format, enrolling 99 scholars from across the nation who made their mark in the industry.

2023 Participant Demographics

From July 9 to July 21, 2023, the 7th REEX Jumpstart program spanned three distinct geographies and five prestigious institutions - Boston's MIT and Harvard, Washington DC's Howard University, and a collaboration with Cornell and New York University, where students resided in the heart of New York City.

A standout among the highlights is the selection of 101 students hailing from 22 states, all of whom were eligible to participate from a competitive pool of over 250 applicants. In the end, a stellar group of 80 scholars completed the intensive two-week REEX Jumpstart program.





KEY ACHIEVEMENTS AND PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

Enriched Collaboration:

- This year, we continued to strengthen our collaborations between renowned universities. Notably, the 1.5-day ULI UrbanPlan workshop saw collaboration with Harvard/MIT and Cornell/NYU, while Howard University participated at The School of Business, further enhancing the program's impact.
- Diversity in Focus: The cohort composition truly represented the program's commitment to diversity. With scholars from 22 states, an impressive 37.5% increase from the previous year, the gender balance was 44% female and 55% male. Our scholars were a mosaic of Black/African American, Hispanic/Latinx, Asian (Pacific), White/Multiracial/Other, and Native American backgrounds.
- Empowering Scholarships: We facilitated a remarkable 38.61% of scholars receiving full scholarships, and 15.84% were awarded partial scholarships, including early enrollment benefits.

Engaging Educational Experiences:

- With support from ULI's District Councils, the program featured ULI's UrbanPlan competitions and Lunch & Learn panels.
- This summer's curriculum was also an introduction to how the commercial real estate industry is addressing concerns about the environment, society and corporate governance ("ESG"). This module was in response to discussions scholars have had in prior year's sessions.

Industry Immersion:

- Exposure to over 50 CEOs, Founders or Managing Principals of commercial real estate companies.
- Daily headline speakers in a masterclass format, taught by diverse industry leaders and members of the Real Estate Executive Council, including Dennis Perkins, Reisa Bryan, Jim Simmons, and Robin Zeigler, enriched the scholars' understanding of CRE fundamentals.
- Site tours and luncheons with over 15 prominent companies and organizations, including VENTAS, Nuveen, Related, Hudson's Bay (Saks Fifth Avenue), Hershey Park Real Estate Group, and Clarion Partners provided invaluable insights into the workings of the real estate industry.

REEX JUMPSTART NATIONAL COMPETITION

The culmination of the REEX Jumpstart Summer Program was the Capstone Project Presentation, done as a competition where each university cohort was divided into teams and made presentations to a panel of judges on a redevelopment project that they had studied over the two-week session. The winners at the university level advanced to the Finals competition on the final Friday of the REEX Program, where a panel of judges reviewed the presentations, and scholars competed for a cash award of up to \$500 for each winning team member. This year's final team winners for the Capstone presentation were Howard University (Session 1) and NYU (Session 2). Our panel of judges included representatives from REEC members, industry leaders and sponsors (REEC, SIOR, NAIOP, Toll Brothers, Artemis Real Estate Partners, and LISC). REEX JumpStart National Competition was a huge success. The winning Team was "Land Creates Capital" representing Howard University. They were presented with a \$1,000 reward each for being 1st place in the competition.









ALUMNI COLLEGE CHART TOP IVY LEAGUES




TOTAL AT HBCUS

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
