Trending Travel Topics

Restrictions and security are afoot and upon us in 2025— especially when it comes to travel. Getting your facts straight and checking all your boxes are in much need of being carefully considered.

Let's get into trending topics and find out why.

<u>Heads Up — You May Need Clearance Before You Travel There?</u>

"Security, Security?!"

The latest talks about travel restrictions are raising eyebrows, especially for those of us in the travel industry. Have you heard of this travel ban list?

Geesh! Its extensive! With proposed changes impacting 43 countries (with more being added,) falling into three categories:

- 1. **Full Visa Suspensions**: This includes places like Iran, North Korea, and Syria—countries already known for travel challenges.
- 2. **Partial Visa Suspensions**: Some countries, such as Haiti and Eritrea, might face limits on specific visa types like tourist or student visas.
- 3. **Conditional Restrictions**: A larger group of countries, like Pakistan and Belarus, could see partial suspensions unless they meet new security requirements within 60 days.

Also, there is a red list, an orange list and a yellow list — which are restricted based on additional and 'other' criteria from address deficiencies to being stopped from travel to the US altogether.

These restrictions are surrounding the growing tensions with trade and security at the US borders among other factors.

These potential restrictions could influence how we plan trips, especially for international wellness retreats or global adventures. For travelers looking to explore regions on the list, it's worth staying updated to avoid last-minute surprises.

On a related note, there's a proposal to restrict Chinese nationals from studying in the U.S., stirring concerns about xenophobia and its ripple effects on education and tourism.

Real ID To Travel

For the majority of us, the **REAL ID** requirement has finally arrived after years of reminders.

Beginning this Wednesday, May 7, the majority of American adults will require a REAL ID in order to enter nuclear power plants, board commercial airplanes subject to federal regulation, and access some federal sites.

In order to board a domestic flight or enter certain federal facilities you will need to have a real ID available - planning ahead is crucial — that's why I'm here for you.

What Is A "Real ID" Card?

REAL IDs are state-issued identification cards or driver's licenses that satisfy the federal government's basic security requirements as outlined in the <u>REAL ID Act</u>, which Congress passed in 2005 at the 9/11 Commission's suggestion. A few exceptions exist.

Additionally, travelers can utilize a U.S. passport, Enhanced Tribal Card, permanent resident card, passport issued by a foreign government, and a number of other kinds of identification that the TSA accepts for air travel.

The Department of Homeland Security also recognizes Enhanced Driver's Licenses (EDLs) and Enhanced IDs (EIDs) from five states as REAL ID substitutes.

- 2. Minnesota
- 3. New York
- 4. The state of Vermont
- 5. Washington

In these states, not all IDs or licenses are automatically improved. During the application procedure, residents have the option of selecting an EDL/EID or a conventional license/ID.

When traveling by land or sea to Canada, Mexico, and the Caribbean, enhanced driver's licenses and enhanced identification documents can also serve as proof of identity and citizenship.

What You Need to Get Your Real ID & FAQ's

1. Verify the requirements in your state.

The first step is to visit your state's Department of Motor Vehicles or similar website for detailed information on how to apply for a Real ID, as each state has distinct procedures and documentation requirements.

2. Assemble the necessary paperwork.

You will need to present a number of documents to confirm your identification, state residency, Social Security number, and U.S. citizenship or legal status.

- <u>Typical documents needed are as follows: A legitimate, unexpired passport, birth certificate, or other kind of official documentation can serve as proof of identity.</u>
- <u>Social Security (SSN) documentation: a W-2 form for your Social Security card or a pay stub that includes your SSN.</u>
- Or, Documents proving U.S. citizenship or legal status include passports, birth certificates, and proof of legal residency.
- <u>Documents proving your current address, such as utility bills, lease agreements, or bank records, are known as proof of residency. Depending on the state, this can require two separate paperwork.</u>

- 3. Visit the DMV or Designated Office
- 4. Fill out the Application
- 5. Have your Photo Taken: This photo will appear on your new driver's license or ID card.
- 6. Once you have completed all steps the easier part is on the horizon! Your Real ID will arrive by mail, so if you have any travel plans. This process can take up to a few weeks depending on your state.

Can I Speed Up This Process?

In some states, such as Pennsylvania, California, New York and Virginia, people seeking a **REAL ID** can pregualify or apply online, then complete the process in person.

Other states, like Texas, Michigan and Oklahoma, complete the entire process in person with no online component.

So far, there is no listed method that will expedite this process. A passport is acceptable in place of Real ID.


