



Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project A Southern California Edison Project

Chino Hills, CA 500 kV (CHUG)

This project involves working with PAR Electric and M.A. Steiner to complete the first 500kV underground project in the country. This project represents 3.5 miles, which is a small portion of a 12 segment, 250 mile long project known as the Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project (TRTP). TRTP is being constructed to deliver renewable solar and wind electricity throughout the greater Los Angeles area.
