Signs

Make sure the bad guys see them sooner rather than later.

*Bring security signs (real or imagined) **closer to the sidewalk.***

Instead of by the front door. We want whoever's looking, to keep it moving.



Cameras

Don't be shy about your use of cameras.

It's ok if they're visible. It's actually encouraged.

To Receive a FREE Light

1. Contact us at 714-831-0025 to schedule an appointment.
2. When fixtures are received, you will be asked to sign an agreement noting the terms of the program (see program criteria).
3. You will have 30 days to install your lights. We recommend using a licensed electrician. If you're income-qualified, installation can be done for free.
4. Approximately 30 days after receiving your lights, call 714-831-0025 to confirm installation.
5. Installations are subject to an inspection.
