Projects can be booked for up to three groups per project. For example, a school may schedule Class A in Autumn Term, Class B in Spring Term, and Class C in Summer Term, with each class receiving 10 weeks of drumming for a total of 30 weeks in a single project slot. Some schools opt to split a single project between two classes, allowing each class 15 weeks of consecutive drumming over the year. However, the most effective approach is delivering a full project to one class across three consecutive terms, ensuring deeper learning, skill progression, and greater impact.
