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INTRODUCTION

I am passionate in sharing with you this gems of supplication to improve our lives, In Sha Allah. I pray that the compilation of all these gems that Allah chose to be included in His final Book is beneficial to me and all the readers. With the resources that I have, my guarantee is to try and practice absolute integrity with the Chapters and Verses, translating as accurate as possible without distorting the meaning of the du'as.

Invocations read by wrong-doers or Iblis will not be included. Examples of such verse by the wrong doers - *"Our Lord! Delay us for a little while. We will respond to Your call and follow the messengers!"* [Quran 14:44] and by Iblis - *"My Lord! Then delay my end until the Day of their resurrection."* [Quran 38:79]

Du'as in this book are not applicable to everyone and sometimes might not be applicable to also be read in full sentences.

Also, perspective and opinions of these Quranic du'as is mine and mine alone. Allah knows the true practicality of these du'as. However, I would be more than happy to hear your point of view if any of you readers have better perspective of its true usage.

INTRODUCTION

Here's are some examples of what I meant:

#1 eg. A lot of the du'as start with "Rabbana" (Our Lord) such as;

رَبَّنَا لَا تُرِغْ قُلُوبَنَا بَعْدَ إِذْ هَدَيْتَنَا وَهَبْ لَنَا مِنْ لَدُنْكَ رَحْمَةً إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْوَهَّابُ

"Our Lord! Do not let our hearts deviate after you have guided us. Grant us Your mercy. You are indeed the Giver." [Quran 3:8]

The verse just after also started with "Rabbana"

رَبَّنَا إِنَّكَ جَامِعُ النَّاسِ لِيَوْمٍ لَا رَيْبَ فِيهِ إِنَّ اللَّهَ لَا يُخْلِفُ الْمِيعَادَ

"Our Lord! You will certainly gather all humanity for the Day, about which there is no doubt. Surely Allah does not break His promise." [Quran 3:9]

However, would [Quran 3:9] still be considered as a du'a?

Though we are affirming to the truth of what Allah is going to do, in my opinion I would not include these in the compilation of du'a (invocation). No doubt all of the Quranic verses are sacred, but the aim of this book is mainly du'as and not on affirmations et cetera.

#2 eg. A powerful du'a spoken by the Wife of Imran was recorded.

رَبِّ إِنِّي نَذَرْتُ لَكَ مَا فِي بَطْنِي مُحَرَّرًا فَتَقَبَّلْ مِنِّي إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

"My Lord! I dedicate what is in my womb entirely to Your service, so accept it from me. You are truly the All-Hearing, All-Knowing." [Quran 3:35]

Definitely this verse will be compiled under the list of du'as. But this invocation due to the structure of the sentence is best read by pregnant Muslim women and not Muslim men.

INTRODUCTION

#3 eg. An impressive du'a of prophet Sulaiman

رَبِّ اغْفِرْ لِي وَهَبْ لِي مُلْكًا لَا يَنْبَغِي لِأَحَدٍ مِّنْ بَعْدِي إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْوَهَّابُ

“My Lord! Forgive me, and grant me a kingdom that will never belong by anyone after me. You are indeed the Bestower.”

[Quran 38:35]

Looking at the grammar of this verse, anyone, be it Muslim men or women can read this du'a. From the verses surrounding this du'a, we can deduce that it is referring to the earthly kingdom (not the afterlife) and we do not know how many individuals came after prophet Sulaiman up until now. So if God granted prophet Sulaiman 999 KU (kingdom units), and person Z that came after him read this du'a (let us assume God grant him/her this supplication) the maximum this person can be granted on earth is 998 (or 998.9999...) KU because no one after him can be granted 999 KU. That's because Allah will never break His promise to anyone. After every supplication is granted, the KU will be reduced due the structure of this du'a. eg. 998..997..996 KU et cetera. We do not know how many person Z has been granted this supplication.

We can also look at this dua as follows; it is well known that after this dua, Allah subjected the wind, the devils, understanding the language of the animals etc to prophet Sulaiman's kingdom. *“that will never belong by anyone after me”* is uniquely given to him that no others can possess. But if Allah so choose, He can still grant you a different unique ability/kingdom that differs from what was given, to prophet Sulaiman, that will be uniquely yours.

Thus, I would say that this du'a is very unique and there is a reason why Allah record this in the Quran, Allah is All-Knowing, and would know what is best for each one of us.
