### BRIEF ABOUT SHIVIR



In spirituality, four stages of liberation are understood: Salokya Mukti, Samipya Mukti, Sarupya Mukti, and Sayujya Mukti. These are also mentioned in our Upanishads, particularly in the Srimad Bhagavatam and the Chandogya Upanishad. The saint from Maharashtra, Sant Dnyaneshwar, also said, "Standing at the door of God even for a moment grants all four liberations." This means that even standing at God's door for a moment can grant all four types of liberation. However, going to God's door does not simply mean visiting a temple, as millions of people visit temples but are not liberated.

Therefore, to teach how to reach God's door and to understand and experience these four types of

liberation, a three-day camp was organized by Sacred Circle in Nagpur from April 4-6, 2025. This camp was called Shri Vishnu Vidya Shivir and was held at Maa Umiya Dham in Pardi. Practitioners from all over India and even from Bahrain attended this camp.

# Attaining Param Pad- Moksha - Ultimate state.

Initially we all (Souls - Atma) were with god (Paramatma) but we came here to experience the Earth but then, we have completely forgotten where we actually belong and struck in the cycle of Karma and rebirth. Earth is best Place to Evolve but it also has the duality and if we don't manage our selves then we will not be able to come out of the viscous cycle of birth, death & rebirth.

Difficulties in life motivate people to get into spirituality. Normally man puts efforts to get Happiness, Comfort, Joy but we slip. We came to earth to enjoy but we have forgotten our original form. Several saints tried to remind us but we still don't take that seriously.

One of the Divine soul Sanat Kumara came from Venus around many years ago to assist in spiritual evolution of early humanity. Sanat Kumara is a profound figure in spiritual lore, revered across various traditions (even mentioned in Bible as Ancient of Day) for his divine mission to uplift humanity. His story is one of immense compassion and selfless service, as he descended to Earth during a time of spiritual crisis to guide souls back to the path of enlightenment. Sanat Kumara is a fascinating figure in spiritual traditions, often associated

#### God is

- 1. Omnipotent: This means that God is all-powerful. God has unlimited power and can do anything that is possible.
- Omniscient: This refers to God being all-knowing. God has complete knowledge of everything, including past, present, and future events.
- Omnipresent: This means that God is present everywhere at the same time. There is no place where God is not present.
- 4. Omnibenevolent: This quality means that God is allgood or infinitely good. God is perfectly good and is the source of all goodness.

The phrase "Param Pad Mein Vishram" embodies the soul's ultimate journey towards divine bliss and eternal peace. It speaks of resting in the infinite, transcendental state where worldly illusions dissolve, and the soul reunites with its true essence—the divine presence. This state signifies liberation from the cycle of birth and death, known as Moksha, and the attainment of supreme tranquility.

In the spiritual sense, "Param Pad" is not a physical location but a sacred state of being. It is the realization of oneness with eternal consciousness, where ego, desires, and attachments vanish. The soul, free from the shackles of material existence, surrenders to the divine light, merging seamlessly with the cosmic truth.



The path to "Param Pad" is illuminated by spiritual practices like meditation, selfless service, and unwavering faith in the higher power. By silencing the mind and seeking inner stillness, one can experience glimpses of this divine rest. The process requires surrender—not out of weakness, but as an act of ultimate strength and trust in the divine will.

"Param Pad Mein Vishram" encourages us to embrace detachment and love. It teaches that eternal bliss is not found in possessions or achievements but in humility, inner purity, and communion with the divine. It is a call to rise above worldly conflicts and live in harmony with the universe's sacred rhythm.

In essence, resting in "Param Pad" is the soul's homecoming—an eternal embrace of love, light, and infinite peace.

At the end of Shivir after learning Sri Vishnu Vidya we experienced Ultimate State which is Param Pad. First, we learnt how to go to Vishnu Lok, then how to go near Lord Vishnu and how to look like him and at the end how one can merge with the Supreme Being, losing one's separate identity.



# 'SHRI VISHNU VIDHYA' RETREAT -STORY OF ITS ORIGIN IN SIR'S OWN WORDS

Everyone knows that toward the end of 2019, the COVID-19 virus engulfed the entire world. India went into lockdown by March 2020. Everything shut down—shops, cinemas, offices, and even stepping out was prohibited.

During that time, I immersed myself in silence and spiritual practice until 16 April 2020. In this period, I had many profound spiritual experiences. I encountered several high-consciousness galactic beings such as the Arcturians, Pleiadians, and Sirians, and received their blessings.

During this spiritual practice, whenever I connected with the Prime Source, the Supreme Being, I always had visions of Lord Vishnu. At that time, I used to write a diary. And many entries in my diary say, 'Today also I had a vision of Lord Vishnu!'

On April 1, 2020, I wrote in my diary: 'As I began connecting with the Prime Source, it felt as though there was no end to it! Whenever I felt I had connected with its essence, I would experience a pull to ascend even higher. Then far higher, beyond wherever I had reached till then. As I continued





rising, I started seeing energy layers, and then a crystal-like, third-eye-like bright light appeared. Upon reaching there, light spread everywhere.'"

Within the third eye, I experienced a massive fire. It became evident that this realm resembled Shivlok, and I had a vision of Lord Shiva.

I continued ascending further—to reach the Prime Source. Then, I saw an expansive spread of bright white light all around, and it felt like there was no need to go beyond this. This was the destination. At that moment, I felt I had reached Vishnu Lok. Lord Vishnu was established within my Sahasrara (crown chakra). Later, His presence spread throughout my entire body, and it seemed that, within the human form, most spiritual progress typically reaches this point. Beyond this lies the journey into the Prime Source itself.

I remained within the third eye for a long time. No thoughts were arising. My entire being was filled with white light. I experienced the Divine Matrix.

There was a sensation like bubbles of white light—something ethereal. The feeling of oneness grew even stronger. I connected with the Prime Source.



During that time, I also used to practice Merkaba meditationOn April 17, 2020, when I Travelled to the Great Central Sun, I saw Lord Vishnu there again—I felt vast expansion—and sensed this was Mahavishnu. He stood before me and then blessed me.

On April 18, 2020, I received darshan again and also discovered the way / technique to connect with him. Once connected, I felt I could conduct healing for any issues and receive answers from him to any question.

The meditation practice went on.

On January 15, 2023, I had mentioned that,"I had meditated on the Blue Avians, the Galactic Beings. Afterward, I felt Lord Vishnu's presence—He held the Sudarshan Chakra and wished to give it to me to heal seekers. But to bear the Sudarshan Chakra is an immense responsibility, and that's why I felt hesitant. I asked him, Can I truly bring this Chakra into practice?' He replied... Yes and granted me permission.

That same afternoon at 4 PM, during our regular group meditation, I invoked Blue Avians, Lord Vishnu, and Lord Krishna through Pillars of Light. They arrived, and I felt it was time to use the Sudarshan Chakra. I received it on the index finger



of my right hand—a spinning bright white divine energy capable of destroying negativity, infused with the power of 10 Mahavidhyas.

I guided this energy through seekers' Earth Star Chakra and all seven chakras—especially the Vishuddhi chakra where Rudra Granthi lies. It is essential to pierce the Rudra Granthi for higher spiritual development. I repeated the process three times, from sahasrar chakra to root chakra and back.

The seekers had powerful experiences. Leena saw the chakra as a 3D golden form, felt bliss as it moved up and down her spine. Many seekers experienced vibrations in their spinal column (Meru Danda). Several felt a subtle movement rising from root chakra upwards.

Lord Vishnu granted me the initiation and permission to wield and use the Sudarshan Chakra. After using it, I respectfully returned it to Him. Yet, I have been blessed with the divine sanction to invoke it at any time, for any purpose.

On January 21, 2023, Leena and I journeyed to the revered town of Udupi in Karnataka—a place graced by the presence of the famed Shri Krishna Temple. After offering our prayers and receiving darshan of the divine idol, we entered the temple's



hall and immersed ourselves in meditation. The atmosphere was steeped in silence and sanctity.

As I sank deeper into stillness, a distinct shift in consciousness occurred. I felt the presence of Lord Krishna—not merely as a deity but as an awakened consciousness. He revealed Himself as an immensely disciplined, no-nonsense Guru—radiating clarity, decisiveness, and boundless wisdom. In that state of sublime communion, He initiated me into a new spiritual responsibility.

With great grace, Lord Krishna permanently entrusted me with the Sudarshan Chakra. His words echoed with divine certainty: 'From now on, this will always remain with you. There is no need to return it. You must also bestow its initiation upon others.'

In that moment, I was enveloped in both reverence and responsibility. What had once been a sacred tool granted was now a permanent companion—a divine force aligned with my purpose, ready to be invoked not only for personal upliftment but for service to others.

Thus, our visit to Udupi became a profoundly significant chapter in our spiritual journey. The blessings we received, the divine encounters, and the quiet revelations all seemed beautifully



orchestrated—as if the universe had gently paved the way.

During this time, we also met Maya Pai ji (Sacred Circle Sadhak) in Udupi.

We also visited Rita Kalya Ji (Sacred Circle Sadhak) at her home in Karkala. She took us to see the idol of Gomateshwara Bahubali located there. Then we went to Sringeri Mutt, founded by Adi Shankaracharya.

Sudarshan Chakra experience was immensely divine and powerful. I knew it had to be taught—but not in a rushed 2-hour online session. Such power requires a receptive and devoted mindset, best cultivated in an immersive residential retreat which I wanted to schedule sometime later.

In December 2024, Vidyut ji of Jammu expressed interest in hosting a residential retreat in Jammu. But for some reason, that shivir (spiritual retreat) could not take place. The discussion about where to organize this shivir took place during a Sunday session. Several seekers suggested that it should be held in Nagpur, as Nagpur is the sacred land of Kshitij. In particular, Rajesh Mallya ji strongly emphasized that the shivir must take place in Nagpur and begin specifically on April 4, as that date marks the birth anniversary of Kshitij. Thus,



the decision was made to conduct the shivir in Nagpur from April 4 to April 6, 2025. While the content was undecided, the enrolment of nearly 100 seekers from our higher level meditation group made it clear that the teachings must be advanced spiritual practices.

An inner guidance emerged that the Sudarshan Chakra initiation must be given. Also, participants should experience / attain the Param Pad (ultimate state) through the gradual experience of the four kinds of liberation mentioned in Indian scriptures—Saalokya, Saanidhya, Svaroopya, and Saayujya mukti with the Lord Vishnu. Hence, the retreat was named — Shri Vishnu Vidya Shivir.

This is how the Shri Vishnu Vidhya Retreat was born.



#### KSHITIJ: A TRIBUTE TO A DIVINE SOUL



Kshitij is not just a memory - he resides in higher dimensions of consciousness, in bliss.

Born on April 4, 1995, and having left his physical body on May 29, 2016, this wasn't the end of a worldly journey but the beginning of a divine presence, still guiding

countless souls today.

Leena Didi shares how Kshitij developed well in the womb but faced severe complications during birth. She told, "Doctors couldn't perform a caesarean and ultimately used forceps, which caused a lack of oxygen and brain injury. He became hyperactive. He was fine from birth until twenty-three months old, just a little more active than usual." He used to get seizures. We made every effort to cure him. We consulted all types of renowned doctors in India—Allopathic, Homeopathic, and Ayurvedic—but nothing helped.



Once Ayurvedic doctor gave him a high dose of Heerak Bhasma, leading to 40 hours of continuous seizures - yet he survived. It was a remarkable case for the doctors, as no one typically survives after so many seizures. For this reason, doctors presented Kshitij's case at various conferences and seminars.

Eventually, he became bedridden, unable to walk or speak, requiring constant care.

When conventional medicine failed, we turned to alternative therapies - Reiki, Pranic Healing, the Silva Method, and Kundalini awakening. Still, there was no effect. Amidst all this, we turned toward spirituality. We let go of worrying about him. Perhaps this, too, had a purpose - that we should connect with the spiritual path. Though physical progress stalled, a deeper spiritual journey began.



Meanwhile, we met Patiwali Aai. Sometimes we would visit her home, and sometimes she would come herself to see Kshitij.

Patiwali Aai's guru was Mata Anusuya of Pardasenga, a highly revered saint. Patiwali Aai is her principal disciple and is known to have



knowledge of all three dimensions of time—past, present, and future. She told us that Kshitij is a divine soul. 'Do not worry about him,' she said. 'You should engage in spirituality'.

Patiwali Aai visited Nagpur many times. She would often come to our home in the evenings. After dinner, there would be a satsang—filled with spiritual discussions. These satsangs would sometimes continue until 2 AM.

On several occasions, the consciousness of her guru, Mata Anusuya, would manifest within her. At those times, even her speech and mannerisms would change. She would appear exactly like Mata Anusuya herself.



One night, the consciousness of Mata Anusuya once again descended. She shared profound spiritual insights. Then she said, "Light the camphor"—a signal that her presence was about to depart. Usually, after camphor was lit, her consciousness would leave Patiwali Aai's

body. But this time, after lighting the camphor, she





waved her hand over it, picked it up, and walked toward Kshitij's room. Both Diwakar ji and I followed her. Inside, Kshitij was asleep on the bed, covered with a mosquito net.

At that moment, the consciousness of Anusuya Mata was still present in Patiwali Aai. She paused briefly, then began to lift the mosquito net. Both of us helped her with it. Kshitij was sleeping on the bed, facing the wall. Anusuya Mata gazed at him for a few moments. As soon as he felt her presence, he turned his face toward her and opened his eyes. They looked into each other's eyes for a while. Then Mata took some flowers in her hands and placed them beside Kshitij, joined her hands in reverence, and began to rise. Kshitij turned his face back toward the wall and closed his eyes. After that, Anusuya Mata's consciousness departed from Patiwali Aai's body. We never knew what silent exchange took place between them. But the way Kshitij turned his face was unusual- he would never do so under normal circumstances."

It seemed that Kshitij used to be always in a state of divine awareness. At night, I would put him to bed, and after he fell asleep, I would go about doing various chores around the house. When I returned to him afterward, he would always move his right foot—perhaps as if to say, "I know you've come near me." No matter how deep his sleep was, he would still do this.




Not only that, even in the morning when I quietly got up from beside him, he would move his foot in the same way—as if to say, "I know you're leaving now."

At no other time would he move his foot like that.

#### Proof of a yogic life:

Meanwhile, our spiritual journey continued. We participated in several spiritual streams including ShivYog, Oshodhara, Parashakti Chikitsa, Samarpan Meditation, Vipassana, Siddha Sanmarg etc. We also received Amma's blessings several times.



Alongside this, we came into contact with Guru Narayan Swami of Om Tapovan. We organized some of his camps in Nagpur and Ballarshah. He has deep knowledge of vital energy (pran shakti). His healing modality is very powerful. He also offers excellent guidance in spirituality and raises awareness of people. He has uplifted thousands.

Once, Guru Narayan Swami came to our home in Nagpur. He saw Kshitij and sensed his flow of vital energy. His Sushumna Nadi was active. After observing further, he said, 'This is a yogic soul. He



is not meant to be healed. He has come to awaken others through his very existence.' That day, Patiwali Aai was also at our home. Upon seeing her, he said, 'She is the embodiment of divine power!'"

At that time, the use of the internet was rapidly growing across the world. Diwakar ji used to read many spiritual books. He kept searching on the internet to see if there were any powers in the world that could heal Kshitij. One day, he came across a website called 'Masters of the Spirit World,' where anyone could ask a question. The masters from the Spirit World would answer those questions. Nobody knew us on that website. He, too, asked about Kshitij - why his health was the way it was.

So, the master from the Spirit World replied: "Kshitij is a great soul. He has deliberately chosen a difficult life path, with your mutual agreement. You are fortunate to have such a divine soul in your life. You are not doing as much for him as he is doing for your spiritual growth. Live this life with even more love."

Months later, I asked the same question again to them without mentioning Kshitij's name. Still, I received the same answer.



Past Life Connection Leena Didi's memory of a past life clarified the mystery behind Kshitij's birth. She shares: "My previous birth took place in Tibet. I lived in an ashram, practiced spiritual disciplines, and performed other duties there. One day, while I was sweeping the ashram premises, a divine monk arrived. He was young, and his face radiated brilliance. He met the head of the ashram and, after some time, prepared to leave. I bowed to him and said, 'Please stay here for a few days. I feel I could serve you. He replied, I have an important task to complete. I must go now. Then, after pausing briefly, he said, 'In the next birth, I will give you the opportunity to serve me. That monk was none other than Kshitii in this present life. And in this birth, by taking birth as my son, he fulfilled his promise.

Even today, I receive his help. Whenever I don't understand something, I remember him and ask - and the answer comes instantly. Sometimes, he even speaks like a teenage child.

This incident took place after Kshitij had left his physical body. Once, we were heading to the ashram for meditation. On the way, the taxi stopped at a petrol station, and the driver asked me for payment.





I began searching for my credit card, but I couldn't find it. I closed my eyes and inwardly said to Kshitij, 'Son, where did I keep the credit card?' Instantly, a corner of my suitcase came into view. I said to Diwakar ji, 'Let's go—I've figured out where the card is.' We paid the driver in cash and continued on our way. When I reached the ashram and opened my suitcase to look at the spot that had appeared in my inner vision, I found that my credit card was indeed right there!

Sometimes he even talks to me like a teenage child of today's generation. These children do not treat their mothers with reverence! They treat them like a buddy and talk with them in a tone as if they are talking to their buddy."

"Let me share a deeply touching experience to illustrate this:"

"On 4th April 2022, I was at the Tungabhadra Project in Hospet. Diwakar ji was the Chairman of the Tungabhadra Board, and he often had to travel on tour from Hyderabad. I used to accompany him.

"We used to stay at a serene and picturesque guest house named 'Vaikunth', perched atop a small hillock near the majestic Tungabhadra Dam. That guest house is a place of quiet grace. Each morning, I would sit in its vast balcony — open to the gentle winds, the rustling trees, and the calm rhythm of nature — and enter into meditation.





"On that particular morning, as I closed my eyes, I slipped into a deep meditative state almost instantly. Usually, I begin my meditation with the Pillars of Light technique. But that day, I was so effortlessly absorbed into stillness that I didn't even realize I had skipped the initial steps. Moments later, a thought gently surfaced: "Wait, I haven't created the Pillars of Light yet!" With a sense, I hurriedly tried to begin the ritual. At that moment, Kshitij arrived. I felt his presence - soft, subtle, yet unmistakably near. And in a teenage boy's tone, he said: "This is what is called 'karmakand' ...ritualism! When you are already in Oneness, what is the need to perform the 'initial technique' of entering into meditation? Just enjoy the meditation. Many people indulge in rituals unnecessarily..!"

His words struck me like a lightning flash of wisdom wrapped in jest. Until that moment, I had always considered rituals to be something entirely different. But that day, I realized: even a meditaion technique can become mechanical, if done without presence.

"Several days after this incident, I sat for meditation in our meditation room in Hyderabad. I was short on time, so I quickly created the Pillars of Light and began the process of entering meditation. That day, he came again. This time, with a gentle firmness, he said: "Not like this — follow the method



properly..!". I was humbled. I learned that even divine shortcuts are not to be taken lightly.

Spirit Guide: Kshitij's life was brief, but his purpose was profound. He came to teach meditation. He is still among us - unseen, yet active. Today, he serves as a spirit guide to many seekers in our group. When they ask him something, the answers come instantly. Those who turn to him for guidance in deep meditation find his support to be profoundly transformative.

In May 2025, a friend's young son left home angrily and disappeared without informing anyone—where he was headed, and his phone was switched off. My friend was deeply distressed. Then she remembered Kshitij. She said, 'Son, I am your aunt! Wherever my son may be, please send him home safely.' And miraculously, her son returned home within few hours.

In one of the meditation sessions, Diwakar ji facilitated an astral journey to Egypt. The seekers travelled astrally to the Sphinx. There, one of the female seekers had a vision of a young Indian yogi. He was her spirit guide. When she asked his name, the yogi replied, 'Shiju.' A few days later, during another meditation session, she saw a picture of Kshitij. The seeker affirmed, 'The Indian yogi I saw near the Sphinx in Egypt was indeed Kshitij.



There are many such stories...

Leena Didi says that, "Kshitij is our first guru. He silently created many circumstances that led us toward meditation. He taught us Courage & patience. His physical condition was such that it turned our attention toward inner practice. A few months before he left his body, I had a deeply profound experiences of meditation. Even now, whenever I need clarity in any situation, I ask him-and the answer comes instantly. These answers are deeply insightful and mature."

This is not the only one case. There are many reported cases where the childeran who left for heavenly abode continued to help the parents and the relatives in their evolution.

Kshitij isn't just a cherished memory — he's a living, guiding consciousness. He is our first guru—who taught us meditation, instilled faith in us, and even today, exists subtly within us, in the cosmic space. His presence reminds us that death is not the end, but a transformation. Divinity does not reside only in the body - it is the boundless loving consciousness itself.

He is not gone.

- He is the breath of our meditations,
- the clarity in our questions,
- the peace behind our prayers.



He is a guiding flame in the cosmic expanse, ever-present, ever-giving.

of a fish (Matsya) to save
the world from a great
deluge. The narrative
begins with King Manu, a
pious ruler, who finds a

small fish in his hands while performing his morning prayers. The fish pleads for protection, fearing larger predators. Manu, moved by compassion, places the fish in a vessel. However, the fish grows rapidly, outgrowing every container, until it is finally released into the ocean. At this point, the fish reveals its divine identity as Lord Vishnu and warns Manu of an impending flood that will submerge the world.

Lord Vishnu instructs Manu to build a large boat and take with him the seeds of all life forms, along with the seven sages (Saptarishis). When the flood arrives, Matsya appears and guides the boat to safety, ensuring the continuity of life and the preservation of knowledge. In this incarnation, Vishnu not only saved mankind from



destruction but also paved the way for the development of a new civilization through the preservation of Vedic knowledge.

Similar instance is mention in Bible, Atlantis The story of Atlantis, the legendary lost city, originates from the ancient Greek philosopher Plato's dialogues, *Timaeus* and *Critias*. According to Plato, Atlantis was a powerful and advanced civilization located "beyond the Pillars of Hercules" (modern-day Strait of Gibraltar). The story begins with Hiranyakashipu, a powerful demon king who obtained a

boon from Lord Brahma, making him seemingly invincible. He could not be killed by man or beast, inside or outside, during day or night, on land or in the sky, or by any weapon. Emboldened by this boon, Hiranyakashipu declared himself God and persecuted those who worshipped Vishnu, including his own son, Prahlada.

Prahlada, despite his father's wrath, remained steadfast in his devotion to Vishnu. When Hiranyakashipu's atrocities reached their peak, Vishnu intervened. He appeared as Narasimha, a form that defied the conditions of the boon—neither fully man nor beast. At twilight (neither day nor night), on the threshold of a courtyard (neither inside nor outside), Vishnu placed Hiranyakashipu on his lap (neither on land nor in the



sky) and used his claws (not a weapon) to kill him. It highlights the creative ways in which divine intervention can overcome even the most formidable obstacles. This incarnation shows that God will go beyond any limitations to protect his devotees and punish evil.

#### Ahobilum Temple in Andra Pradesh



Ahobilam is a cluster of temples located in the mountain ranges of the Eastern Ghats in the Ahobilam village, Kurnool district, Andhra Pradesh. The temple complex has nine shrines to Lord Nrisimha located around a 5 KM circle, and there is also a temple for Prahaladavarada Varadhan in the foothills of the mountain. It is the only place where all the nine forms of Lord Narasimha Swamy are worshipped.

Ahobilam is a sacred site in the Nallamala Hills, known as the holy abode of Lord Narasimha, an incarnation of


Lord Vishnu in man-lion form. Legend has it that this is where Lord Narasimha killed Hiranyakasipu and saved Prahalada. The initial temples were built by Chalukyas in the 8th century, but most of the current structures were rebuilt by Vijayanagara kings around the 15th century. However, in 1578, the Mughal army caused significant damage to these temples.

The temple complex houses nine shrines, dedicated to a unique form of Lord Narasimha. These forms represent various aspects of the deity, from his fierce and protective nature to his tranguil and meditative state

- Jwala Narasimha Fiercest form, where the Lord appears at the moment of slaying Hiranyakashipu.
- 2. Ahobila Narasimha The main deity. Ugra Narasimha, residing in the upper Ahobilam.
- Malola Narasimha The most benevolent form. seated with Lakshmi Devi.
- Kroda Narasimha Boar-faced aspect symbolizing Varaha-Narasimha.
- Karanja Narasimha Lord under a Karanja tree, holding a bow (rare).
- Bhargava Narasimha Worshipped by Sage Bhargava.
- 7. Yogananda Narasimha Lord in a meditative posture, who taught yoga to Prahlada.
- 8. Chatravata Narasimha Surrounded by banyan trees, fond of music.
- 9. Pavana Narasimha The most peaceful and accessible form, known to purify sins.



Vaman Avtar - This avatar underscores the themes of humility, devotion, and the importance of balance in the universe.



The Vamana Avatar is the fifth incarnation of Lord Vishnu, symbolizing humility and the restoration of cosmic balance. In this form, Vishnu appeared as a dwarf Brahmin to subdue the pride of the Asura king Mahabali and reclaim the three worlds for the Devas. Mahabali, though a benevolent and just ruler, had grown immensely powerful,

threatening the balance of power between the Devas and Asuras. To address this, Vishnu incarnated as Vamana, a diminutive Brahmin boy, during a grand yajna (sacrifice) conducted by Mahabali. True to his generous nature, Mahabali promised to grant Vamana any wish. Vamana humbly requested three paces of land, measured by his own feet. Mahabali agreed, despite warnings from his guru, Shukracharya, about Vamana's divine nature. As soon as the promise was made, Vamana expanded to a colossal size. With his first step, he covered the Earth; with his second, he spanned the heavens. For the third step, Mahabali offered his own head, demonstrating his humility and devotion. Impressed by Mahabali's virtue, Vishnu granted him a boon to rule the netherworld and visit his people once a year, celebrated as the festival of Onam in Kerala.



# Parshuram Avtar - Symbolizing justice, discipline, and the protection of dharma.



The Parashurama Avatar is the sixth incarnation of Lord Vishnu, symbolizing justice, discipline, and the protection of dharma. Parashurama, meaning "Rama with an axe," is depicted as a Brahmin warrior, combining the wisdom of a sage with the valor of a Kshatriya. Born to Sage Jamadagni and Renuka,

Parashurama's life was marked by his unwavering devotion to his parents and his fierce sense of justice. The most famous legend associated with him involves the tyrannical king Kartavirya Arjuna, who coveted the divine cow Kamadhenu owned by Jamadagni. When the king forcibly took the cow and later killed Jamadagni, Parashurama vowed to avenge his father's death.

In his rage, Parashurama waged a campaign against the Kshatriyas, who had become corrupt and oppressive. He is said to have rid the Earth of Kshatriyas 21 times, restoring balance and dharma. Despite his warrior-like actions, Parashurama is also known for his humility and devotion to Lord Shiva, from whom he received his divine axe. Parashurama is considered one of the Chiranjivis (immortals) and is believed to reappear as the mentor of Lord Vishnu's final avatar, Kalki, at the end of the Kali Yuga.

- Agni Chitta Agni Tattva (the fire element) is deeply connected to Chitta (the mind or consciousness) in yogic and spiritual traditions. Agni



The pituitary gland holds profound spiritual significance, often linked to the Third Eye Chakra (Ajna Chakra) in various spiritual traditions.


 Bridge Between Realms: In spiritual practices, the pituitary gland is thought to act as a bridge

Piercing this knot allows the Kundalini energy to reach the Sahastrara Chakra, leading to selfrealization and unity with the divine.



- Dhumavati: The widow goddess, symbolizing the void, detachment, and the darker aspects of existence.
- Bagalamukhi: The goddess of power and control, known for her ability to paralyze enemies and protect devotees.
- Matangi: The goddess of inner knowledge, music, and creativity, representing the power of speech and wisdom.
- 10.Kamala: The goddess of prosperity, wealth, and fertility, often associated with Lakshmi, symbolizing material and spiritual abundance.



## FOUR STAGES OF LIBERATION

## Sālokya Mukti

- Liberation in which the soul resides in the same loka (realm or world) as the divine (e.g., Vaikuntha, Kailasa).
- One stays close to the deity but retains a distinct identity.

## Sāmīpya Mukti

- Liberation that grants the soul nearness or closeness to God.
- The soul becomes an intimate attendant or companion of the divine.

## Sārūpya Mukti

- The liberated soul takes on a form similar to that of the deity—sharing similar features, radiance, and appearance.
- This implies spiritual closeness and equality in divine form, though not in essence.

## Sāyujya Mukti

- The highest form of liberation—complete union with the Divine.
- The individual self merges with the Supreme Being, losing separate identity.

Despite his rigorous efforts, he realized that these practices were not leading him to the ultimate truth he sought.


One day, as he tried to cross the river, his body was so frail that he could barely stand. Midway through the river, he became too weak to take another step and clung to a branch for support.

# STORY ABOUT GURU NANAK DEV JI AND COUNTING UP TO 13, TERA



When Guru Nanak Dev Ji was young, his father gave him a job to work in a nearby shop. His job was to weigh goods and keep accounts for customers — like a small storekeeper.

As Guru Nanak Ji was weighing the goods, he would count: "One, two, three... ten, eleven, twelve..." — but when he reached thirteen, he said "Tera", which in Punjabi means both "thirteen" and "Yours" (belonging to You, O Lord).

When he said "Tera," Guru Nanak Ji became deeply absorbed in divine love, realizing: "Everything is Yours, O God. Nothing belongs to me." In that state of bliss, instead of continuing to count, he just kept repeating,

#### "Tera, Tera, Tera..." i.e ("Yours, Yours, Yours...")

He forgot about the goods, the shop, the customers he was in pure devotion, feeling that all the world belonged to God. People gathered around, seeing young Nanak standing there, eyes shining, lost in joy, chanting "Tera." His father was called and became worried - he thought Nanak was not doing his work properly.

After Guru Nanak Dev Ji's enlightenment at the River Bein, when he returned after three days, the very first thing he shared — the truth he had realized — was the message of Ek Onkar. He expressed it in a divine composition, which today is called the Mool Mantar (or Mul Mantra), the essence of Sikhism. The very first words he spoke were:

"Ik Onkar, Sat Naam, Karta Purakh, Nirbhau, Nirvair, Akaal Moorat, Ajooni, Saibhang, Gur Prasad."

Ik Onkar: There is only one God.

Satnam: His name is Truth.

Karta Purakh: He is the Creator. Nirbhau: He is without fear.

Nirvair: He is without hate.

Akaal Moorat: He is timeless and eternal. Ajooni: He is beyond birth and death.

Saibhang: He is self-existent.

Gurprasad: He is realized through the Guru's grace.





This was around the year 1499, when he had his divine experience. This chant emphasizes the unity of God and the divine qualities that transcend human limitations. It serves as a reminder of the eternal truth and the path of righteousness.

All the gurus in linage of Guru Nanak Dev Ji emphasized the devotion and surrender to Guru & they composed number of beautiful songs called Shabad in praise of Partmantama & Guru.

#### THE MYSTERY OF CHILD DIWAKAR'S BIRTH

For the first time, Sir opened up about a deeply personal chapter of his life - the story of his birth, wrapped in mystery and divine symbolism.

He was born in 1965 in a serene little village named Mahadwadi, nestled in the heart of Maharashtra. His parents were humble farmers, deeply rooted in their land, and blessed with a beautiful home that echoed with laughter and simplicity. Among five siblings Sudhakar, Dhanurdhar, Shri Krishna, Diwakar, and Kamal — each had their unique place in the family.

Shri Krishna was born during a year of extraordinary abundance for the Raipure Family. The family had harvested a bumper crop, and everything seemed to fall into place effortlessly. Their mother who was extremely sensitive always believed this prosperity was a divine gift that came with Shri Krishna's birth.

Years later, Diwakar Sir would recall a moment his mother once shared with him - a moment that would

forever remain etched in his memory. She said, "When you were born and when I was in our home's delivery room, It was early morning — around 5 o'clock. In that sacred stillness, I saw a divine being standing outside my room. He was dark blue in colour, radiant, unmistakably otherworldly. I knew it was some form of God. But I was still angry... I cried out to Him, 'I don't want to see you! I don't want to speak to you! You took away my Shri Krishna.' With a quiet compassion, the divine being responded, "Yes, I have taken Shri Krishna back. But I have come again... and given you another child in his place. Be happy with him." That child was Diwakar. (Our Raipure Sir)

Even several months after Raipure Sir's birth, his mother remained in deep sorrow, and her health continued to decline. Worried for her well-being, a family member suggested visiting a revered holy man who lived nearly 35 kilometers away from their village. When they finally met him, the holy man spoke to Raipure Sir's mother in mystical words: "The one who has departed was an embodiment of Dhan Laxmi, and the one who has born now is a blessing of Vidya Laxmi." These words, though enigmatic, brought her a small measure of relief, easing her sorrow just a little.

As Diwakar grew, life did not unfold easily. The family, once surrounded by abundance, was soon tested by severe hardships. Financial challenges compelled young Diwakar to temporarily drop out of school. Yet, with resilience and a twist of fate, he was able to resume his

In school, during childhood Diwakar was considered an average student. One day, while learning multiplication of two-digit numbers, he found himself completely lost. His teacher tried repeatedly, but something wasn't connecting. The frustration grew on both sides — the teacher's patience wore thin, and Diwakar's confidence began to crumble.

Then, one evening, sitting alone at home in quiet? reflection, something unusual happened. In a sudden flash of clarity, the concept that had eluded him for so long became crystal clear. It was as if a light had been switched on inside him, he next day, he confidently solved the problem in class. His teacher, astounded, asked how he had managed to learn it overnight. Diwakar simply smiled. A spark had been lit - and it never faded.

From that moment on, his academic journey soared. As his village school had education only up to class III, he had to walk about 10 km daily for continuing further education. However, he excelled in his studies, topping the district in his 4th. 7th and 10th Board exams.

Eventually, he became the first student from his district to feature in the SSC merit list. Driven by determination and brilliance, he pursued Civil Engineering from Government Engineering College, Amravati, and went



on to complete his M.Tech. from the prestigious IIT Madras.

Today, Raipure-Sir serves the nation as a senior official in the Ministry of Water Resources, Government of India — a living embodiment of resilience, grace, and perhaps, divine design.

making it difficult to manage their daily livelihood.



His teachings emphasized Advaita Vedanta philosophy, yoga, and devotion to Lord Vithoba, an incarnation of Vishnu. He is also known for miraculous acts, such as making a buffalo recite the Vedas and riding a moving wall to humble a yogi named Changdev. Dnyaneshwar's life was marked by challenges, including societal rejection



due to his family's circumstances. Yet, he rose above these difficulties, inspiring countless followers and founding the Varkari Bhakti movement.

Sant Gyaneshwar faced numerous challenges throughout his life, many of which stemmed from societal norms and personal hardships:

- Social Ostracism: His family was ostracized because his father, Vitthal Pant, had renounced the world and later returned to family life, which was against societal norms. This led to rejection and discrimination from the community.
  - How he overcame. Gyaneshwar's profound spiritual wisdom and teachings helped him rise above societal judgment. He focused on spreading knowledge and devotion, emphasizing equality and compassion.
- Loss of Parents: Gyaneshwar lost his parents at a young age, leaving him and his siblings to fend for themselves.

Changdev decided to challenge Gyaneshwar and sent him a blank letter, unable to decide how to address himneither as a child nor as a saint. Gvaneshwar's sister. Muktabai, responded to the blank letter with a sharp yet insightful reply: "Even though your age is 1,400 years, you are still as blank as your letter." This reply humbled Changdev, and he decided to meet Gyaneshwar in person.

Changdev arrived in grand style, riding a tiger and wielding a serpent as a whip, showcasing his supernatural powers. However, Gyaneshwar and his siblings welcomed him in an extraordinary way—they rode a moving wall to meet him. This act demonstrated Gyaneshwar's mastery over not just living beings but even inanimate objects, surpassing Changdev's powers. Witnessing this, Changdev realized the limitations of his pride and siddhis. He



prostrated before Gyaneshwar, acknowledging his spiritual supremacy. This encounter transformed Changdev, and he became a devoted follower of Gyaneshwar. Sant Gyaneshwar's resilience and unwavering faith allowed him to transform adversity into opportunities for spiritual growth and societal change. His legacy continues to inspire millions.

He attained samadhi in 1296 at Alandi, where his legacy continues to be honoured.




## QUANTUM PHYSICS (The below content sourced from publicly available information on the internet.)

  However, when we zoom in to the microscopic
  world—at the level of atoms and subatomic
  particles—things start to behave very differently.
  Newton's laws don't capture the strange quantum
  behaviors exhibited by particles, such as
  superposition, wave-particle duality, or quantum
  entanglement. At this scale, quantum mechanics
  takes over.
- The double-slit experiment is a fascinating demonstration of quantum mechanics and waveparticle duality. Here's a breakdown of the particle movement in this experiment:

## The Double-slit experiment

Imagine a setup with two narrow slits and a barrier behind them to capture particles, like electrons or photons. When individual particles are fired at the slits, you'd expect them to behave like tiny bullets, forming two distinct patterns on the barrier directly behind each slit. However, that's not what happens.



Wave-like Behavior:
When both slits are open, particles create an interference pattern on the barrier, resembling waves interacting





rather than behaving like individual particles. Peaks and troughs of these waves overlap, producing alternating bright and dark bands on the barrier.

Particle-like Behavior: If you observe which slit the particle goes through (introducing a detector), the interference pattern disappears, and the particles behave as if they're classical entities going through one slit or the other.

The double-slit experiment reveals that particles like electrons or photons exist in a probabilistic wave-like state until measured. When unobserved, they seem to explore all possible paths simultaneously, but observation collapses this state into a definite position or path, demonstrating the peculiar nature of quantum mechanics.

When particles like electrons or photons are fired at a barrier with two slits, something strange happens:

- With no observer: The particles create an interference pattern—like waves—suggesting they go through both slits at once, behaving like pure potential.
- When observed: The particles behave like solid particles, going through only one slit, and the interference pattern disappears.

This suggests that the act of observation or conscious awareness affects the outcome—shifting potential into reality. This is the principal behind healing.



## The Micius Satellite Experiment (2017)- (The below)

China launched a satellite named "Micius" (after a Chinese philosopher) in 2016, and in 2017, they used it to demonstrate quantum entanglement across space—something never done before on this scale.

1.Entanglement Over 1,200 km: -Chinese scientists successfully sent entangled photon pairs from the Micius satellite to two ground stations that were over





1,200 kilometers apart. This was the longest distance ever achieved for quantum entanglement at the time.

2.Unbreakable Quantum Communication: They used entanglement to create a secure quantum communication channel-a form of quantum cryptography that is theoretically unhackable, since any attempt to intercept the photons would disturb them and be immediately detectable.

3.Quantum Teleportation: They also teleported quantum states of particles from Earth to the satellite, demonstrating another key quantum technology (note: teleportation of information, not matter).

#### Why It Was a Big Deal:

- This was the first space-based proof of quantum entanglement over such distances.
- It laid the foundation for a global quantum internet, where information can be exchanged securely via entangled particles.
- It confirmed that entanglement works even in space, proving it's not limited by gravity or Earth's atmosphere.

Spiritual and Philosophical Echo: Just as entangled particles remain connected over vast space, this project information, symbolized how eneray. consciousness may be fundamentally interconnected, regardless of distance-a theme deeply resonant in spiritual philosophies.



## THE MYSTERY OF THE VISHNU STATUE IN UNDAVALLICAVE.



The Undavalli Caves are monolithic Indian rock-cut architecture, located near Vijayawada. It is one of the centrally protected Monuments of National Importance. These monolithic caves date back to the 4th-5th century CE and are associated with the Vishnukundina kings. Originally shaped as Jain caves, they later became a site for Buddhist monks and eventually Hindu worship.


Although Raipure-Sir and Lina-didi have visited Vijayawada many times before, they had never been to this place. It was only after the announcement of the Nagpur Shivir that they happened to pass by Vijayawada and visit this Cave (i.e on 7th Feb 2025). There was some divine intervention that led them to this





place, which will be revealed to you all at the end of this section.

The cave is a four-story structure featuring a massive statue of Vishnu reclining on the serpent SheshaNag, sculpted from a single block of granite.

When Sir and Didi reached the Undavalli cave on the morning of 7th Feb 2025, they did not know about the sculptures in the cave. They started exploring the caves from the ground floor. When they reached the second floor, they found a large reclining idol of Lord Vishnu at the farthest end. Normally, no puja or rituals are offered to the idol. Sometimes, people put garland at the neck



or offer flowers at the feet of the idol. Lina-didi thought, "Oh, you are here too!" They explored the idol for a few minutes.

At one point of time, Raipure-Sir was a bit ahead at the mid portion of the idol, trying to capture the full view. Lina-didi was at the feet of the idol. She touched the knee of the idol, closed her eyes and tried to feel vibrations of the idol.

However, she received an inner guidance saying, "No, don't touch there. Touch the right foot!" However, the message was very subtle. It was not like an order or even instruction. It was just a soft suggestion.

#### STORY OF SANT NAMDEV JI



Born around 1270 CE in Narsi Bahmani village (present-day Maharashtra). His family belonged to a tailor or washerman caste, but he was deeply inclined toward spiritual life from childhood.

He was a devotee of Vithoba (Vitthal), the form of Lord Krishna worshipped in Pandharpur.

Namdev was closely

associated with Sant Dnyaneshwar, Sant Goroba Kumbhar, Sant Chokhamela, and others in the Varkari movement.

Namdev later travelled to North India, including Punjab, spreading the message of Naam (God's name).

He sang devotional hymns in praise of the formless God (Nirguna Brahman).

Guru Nanak Dev ji, the first Sikh Guru, held Namdev ji in high regard.

- 61 of Namdev's hymns were included in the Guru Granth Sahib, the Sikh holy scripture.
- He emphasized God is everywhere, not just in temples.



- His bhajans (devotional songs) are filled with love, humility, and surrender.
- He taught that God does not care for caste or ritual, only for the purity of heart.
- Sant Namdev is believed to have attained samadhiin 1350 CF.
- He is revered in Maharashtra as a Varkari saint, and in Punjab as a spiritual teacher whose words are eternal.

From a young age, Namdev showed signs extraordinary devotion. He would often sit before the Vithoba temple and sing to the deity as though the Lord were physically present.

#### The Roti Miracle

- As a child, Namdev was sent by his Father to offer a roti (bread) to Lord Vitthal.
- He placed the roti in front of the idol and waited with childlike innocence for the deity to eat it or else dad, might punish him.
- When nothing happened, Namdev wept sincerely, begging Vitthal to accept his offering.
- Moved by his pure devotion, Lord Vitthal manifested and ate the roti. This event became legendary, showing that God responds to true devotion, not ritual.



### **BARDO**

When someone dies, in Tibetan Buddhism, it's believed that the consciousness enters a transitional state called the Bardo—a kind of in-between space between death and rebirth.

During this time, specific prayers, chants, and readings are performed to:

- · Guide the consciousness through this state
- · Help the soul recognize the clear light of awareness
- · Reduce fear and attachment
- Aid in a favourable rebirth or liberation from the cycle of rebirth altogether

## The Chanting and Singing Rituals

These rituals are deeply beautiful and solemn. Monks or lamas chant:

- Passages from the Bardo Thödol
- Prayers to Avalokiteshvara, Amitabha, or other Buddhas and Bodhisattvas
- Mantras like "Om Mani Padme Hum" (compassion) or "Phat" (used to cut attachments)

#### These are believed to:

- · Remind the soul of its true nature
- Help it stay calm and not be afraid of the visions and experiences in the Bardo
- Guide it toward the light and away from confusion



Why Singing Is Used The use of melody and chanting is important because:

- Sound is considered a powerful carrier of spiritual energy
- · The vibrations can soothe the soul
- They can also pierce through veils of ignorance in the Bardo

In Tibetan culture, they believe that even after death, the consciousness remains aware for some time—so hearing these sacred chants helps it orient and choose liberation.



#### THEORY OF ENLIGHTENMENT

In the spiritual context, the "supreme state" often refers to the highest level of spiritual realization and consciousness. This state is characterized by profound inner peace, ultimate truth, and unity with the divine.

In Hinduism, the supreme state is known as Moksha or Nirvana. It signifies liberation from the cycle of birth and rebirth (samsara) and the realization of one's true nature as part of the divine essence (Brahman).

In Buddhism, the supreme state is often referred to as Enlightenment or Bodhi. It represents the ultimate understanding and awakening to the true nature of reality, free from ignorance and suffering.

In broader spiritual terms, the supreme state can be seen as a condition of heightened consciousness and inner harmony. It involves transcending ordinary perceptions and aligning oneself with higher truths and divine realization. This state is associated with profound knowledge, peace, and freedom from worldly attachments

## DIVINE MESSAGE FROM LORD VISHNU WHILE VISITING SRI LAKSHMI NARAYANI GOLDEN TEMPLE



On 16<sup>th</sup> March 2025 i.e a couple of weeks before the Nagpur Shivir, Raipure-Sir & Lina-Didi had been to Vellore to visit Sri Lakshmi Narayani Golden Temple. The temple is situated at the foot of a small range of green hills at Thirumalaikodi, Vellore in Tamilnadu, India. It is 120 km from Tirupati and 145 km from Chennai. The Vimanam and Ardha Mandapam of there temple is covered with pure gold.



The temple is spread across 100 acres and one has to walk for several hours to see the main sections of the Temple. There are several small temples, carvings, sculptures, gardens, shops etc along the walkway.



Lina-Didi and Raipure-Sir spent about 2 hours and when they were returning back after visiting the main temple, they found a small temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu near the exit of the walkway. 









