

Healing & Glory Encounters Events

This document will give you information regarding the vision and the idea behind these events. They will give you an understanding as to why we are undertaking this tour and what the purpose is. If you decide to be involved in the *Healing and Glory Encounter Events* tour, then we expect you to flow with the vision, support the vision and align yourself with the vision.

The Vision:

Why are we doing what we are doing?

The vision is to see cities and churches across the United Kingdom impacted with the manifest presence and power of God, along with a release of prophecy and healing. We are aiming to see the United Kingdom transformed region by region by giving life back to the cities and calling them to their true purpose in God.

History:

Part of the vision of Doxa Encounters Ministries is focused on releasing the prophetic, healing and the manifest presence of God into churches and cities in the United Kingdom and internationally.

In order to align with the United Kingdom mission, Doxa Encounters Ministries started holding protracted 3-5 nightly meetings for the above in Portsmouth once a year over the last five years, as a starting point and for the last two years; a test to see how it would work on the road with a revival mindset.

Some of the vision came with the idea of the old traveling revival tent meetings of the USA 1950's healing revivals- but in a new modern wineskin and anointing for today; traveling healing revival events across the United Kingdom.

In the original mission the Holy Spirit gave, there was to be a two-way flow between evening meetings and daytime street events.

May and June 2024 Doxa joined with Steve Abley who leads National Heart of Worship and journeyed together in order to test run what a traveling healing, prophecy, manifest glory events would look like on the road with both street events and evening meetings. Movement in Worship additionally became involved alongside Doxa and Nation Heart of Worship as the three ministries partnered together. *The Healing and Glory Encounter Events* tour became a movement that joined

together with three ministries for the purpose of impacting cities in the United Kingdom.

The Evening Meetings:

The evening meetings are to be open meetings for the church in the city to encounter physical healing, the prophetic and the manifest presence and power of God. The evening meetings will be for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the church and fresh fire to ignite the church in that city. The meetings are to give an opportunity for Christians, churches and even non-Christians to have a fresh encounter with the Holy Spirit, experience the manifest presence of God's glory, repent and 'get right with God', encounter the prophetic and pray for those needing healing. The evening meetings will be more prophetic and for the building up the local city church.

The format for these meetings will be free flowing worship led by Steve Abley. The worship will be prophetic and centred on His presence and face. The worship will also include prophetic flag waving/dancing by Movement in Worship through the whole evening. Mark Gamblin from Doxa will then speak for a very short time, flowing with the Holy Spirit and releasing the prophetic and heavenly realms into the meeting. There will then be ministry time for those needing healing and prayer.

The Streets:

The street events connect in with the evening meetings and continues the same theme. Instead of the presence of God, the Holy Spirit, healing and the prophetic inside a building- it flows out into the streets. This will also include more of an evangelistic element.

Worship

This will include 5-6 hours of non- stop prophetic worship. Worship is led by Chris Millin alongside Fiona Poulson. The worship will also include prophetic flag waving by Movement in Worship as the spiritual environment is challenged over the city.

Prophecy/Healing

Alongside worship, just as in the evening meetings, prophecy and healing will flow, but this time into the streets. There will be teams of people, praying for, prophesying over and leading non-Christians into encounters with Jesus. This becomes evangelistic and is led by Michele Winter.

Unity:

Unity will play a key theme across the tour, the team stand in one accord and one purpose with a clear vision on the purpose of the tour.

All the core team supports one another in unity and fellowship. In the evening meetings, there is unity between Mark Gamblin and Steve Abley. When Steve is leading worship, he is in fellowship with the leading of the Holy Spirit. When Mark preaches he is endeavouring to be in unity with what the Holy Spirit is showing him. The Movement in Worship flag waving additionally flows in unity with both Steve and Mark.

There is unity between the evening meetings and the street meetings so they are not two separate events but the same. There is unity between the street worship and the prophecy/healing team.

The core team support and help one another, submit to one another out of love and fellowship. There is no ego and pushing of an agenda. The core teams pray for one another and sacrificially stand with one another out of love and for the glory and honour of Jesus.
