EDITOR'S NOTES

The May TSC meeting will feature Cartography as the presentation topic as it is a wide ranging subject that may be approached in many ways starting by using a vintage map to enhance your country collection. Almost all countries have issued stamps showing their country in whole or in separate sections, regions, or states. In addition to this, First Flight covers in many cases show air routes and maps of the region covered. This allows one to collect a more local or regionalized area than offered by government issued stamps.

Covers can also be created by using vintage state, region or country maps then folded become a unique and interesting and inexpensive cover.

Our Vice President, Len Miller did an excellent presentation of the stamps of Chile, which was made more interesting when he shared his life and work experiences while teaching for a copper mining company in Chile. 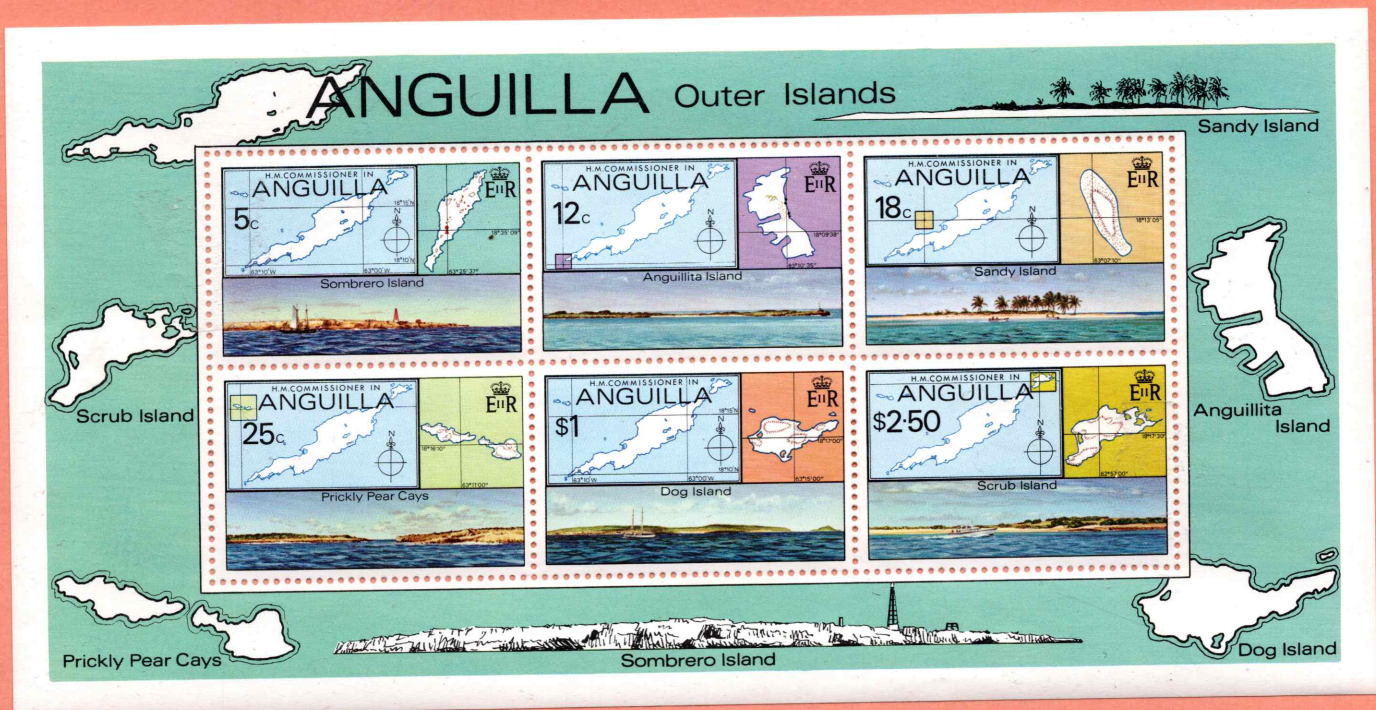

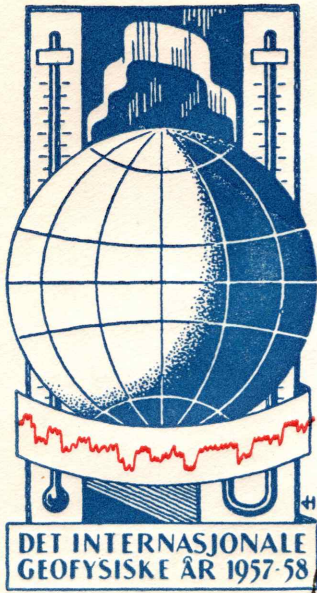
North American Cartographic Information Society's web site, while not a stamp related site, offers an abundance of map related information including a student map

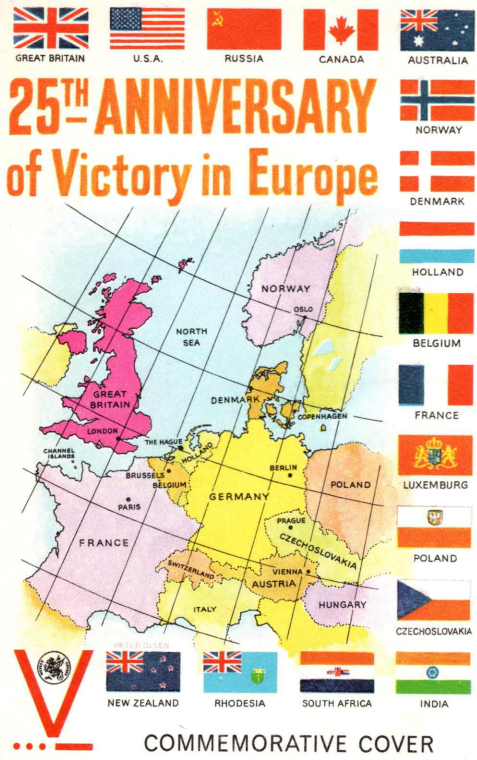

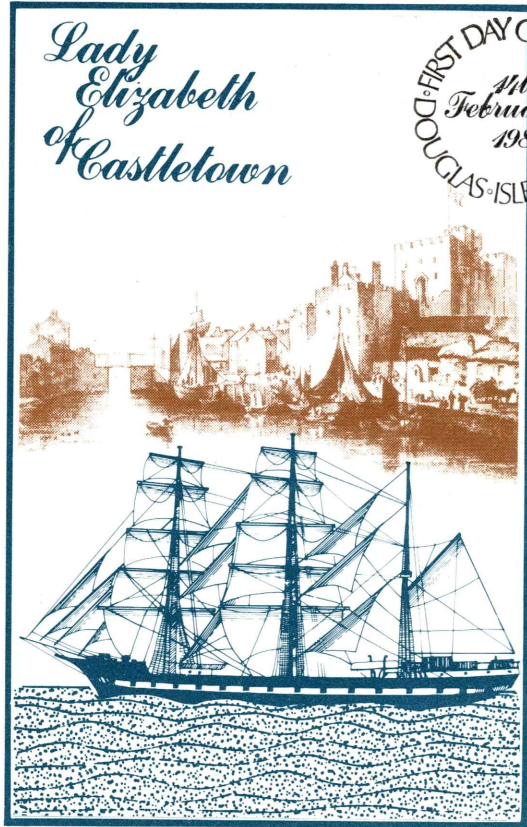


Isle of Man Post Office Official First Day Cover

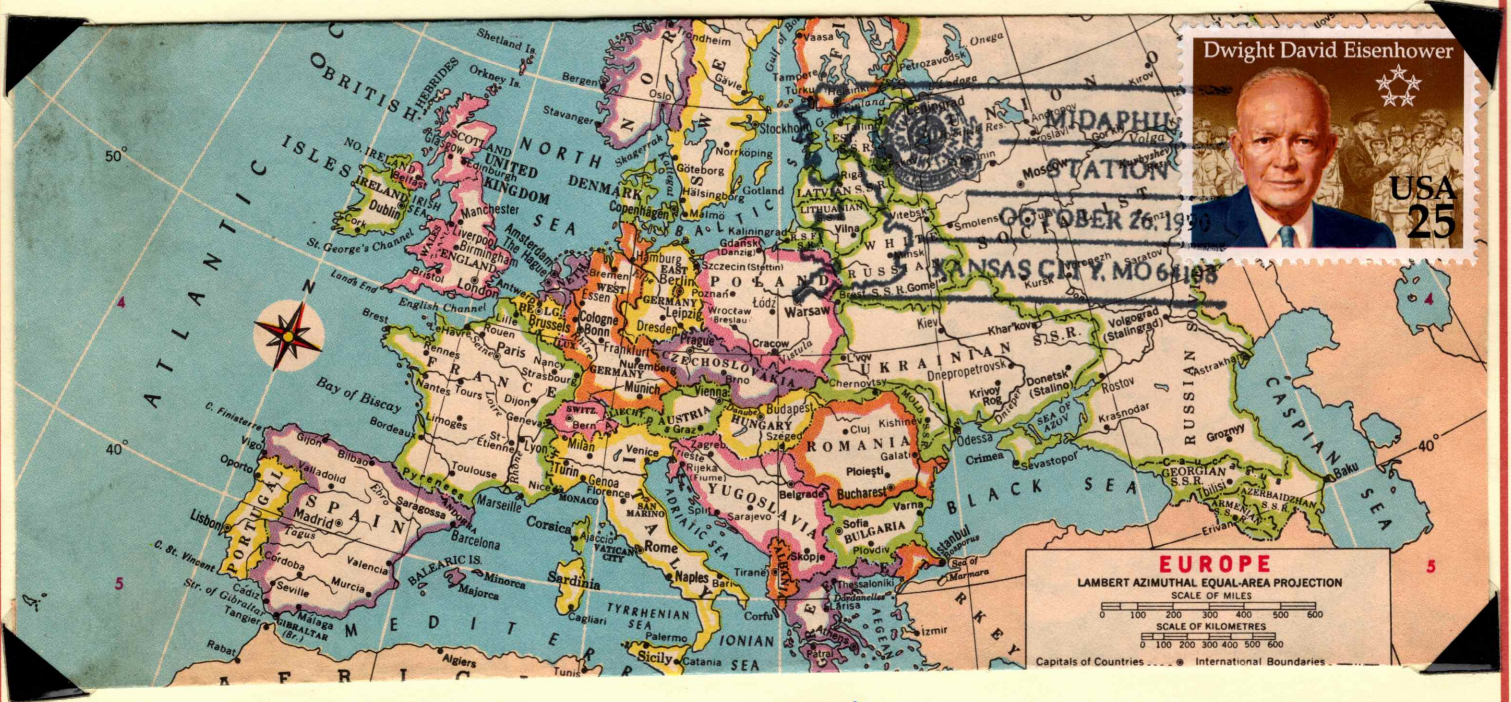

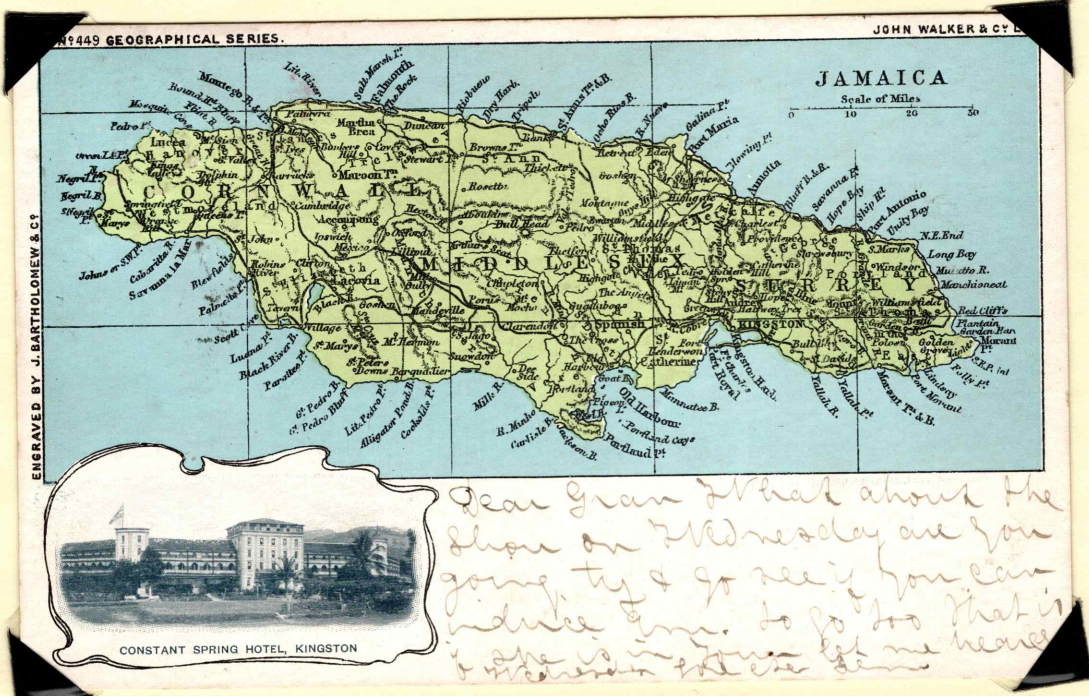

map of Europe Folded into a cover

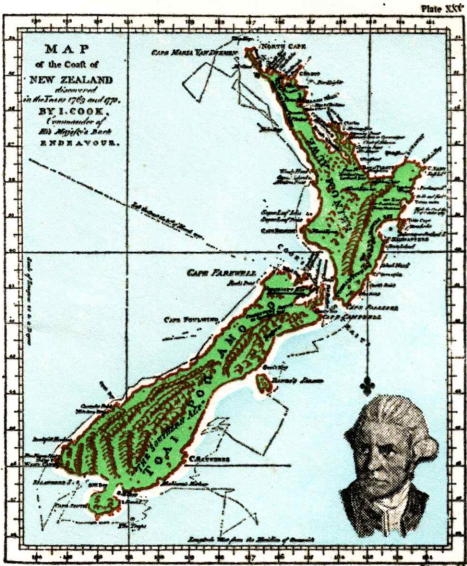

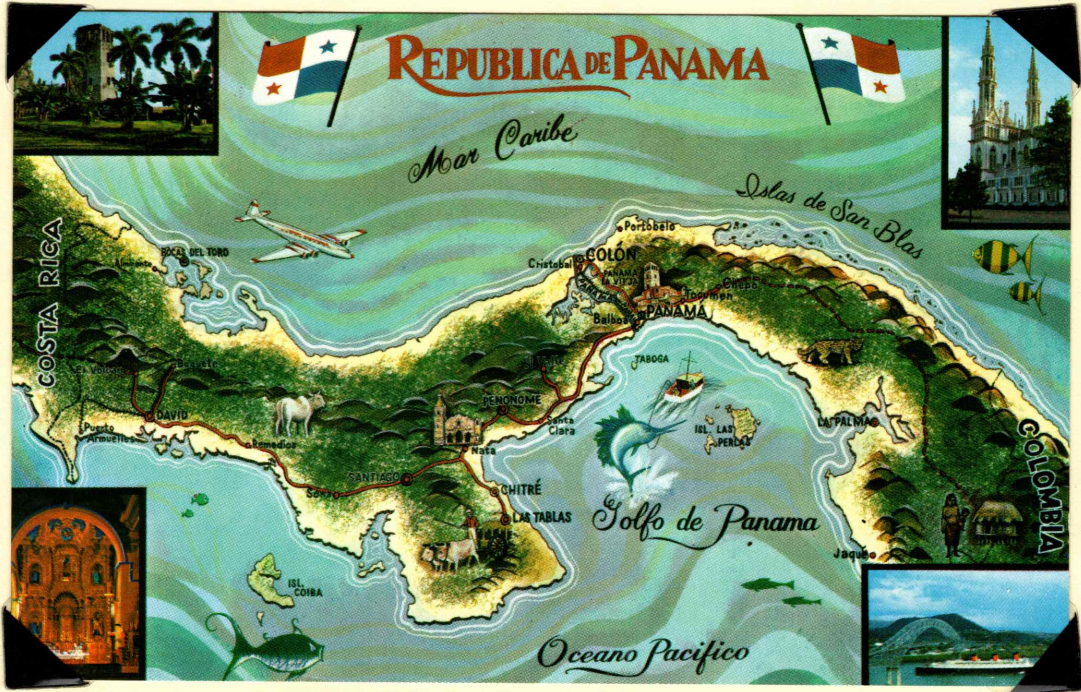

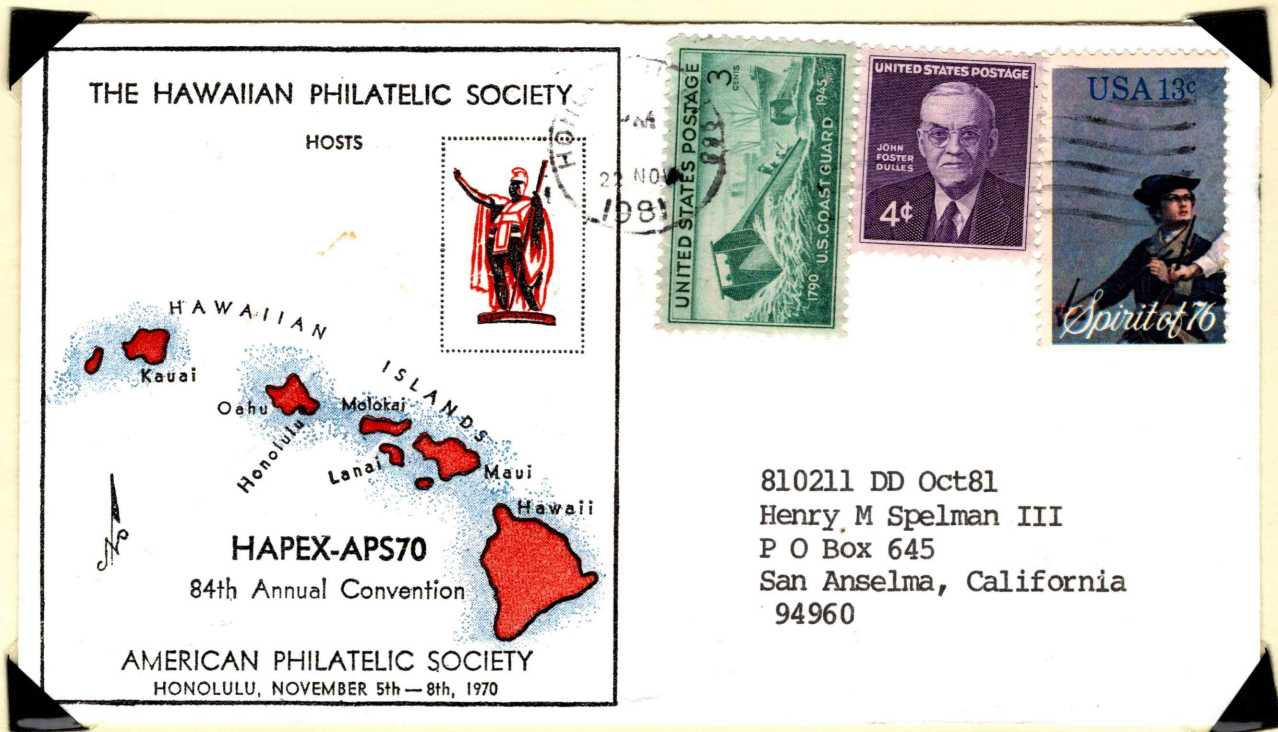

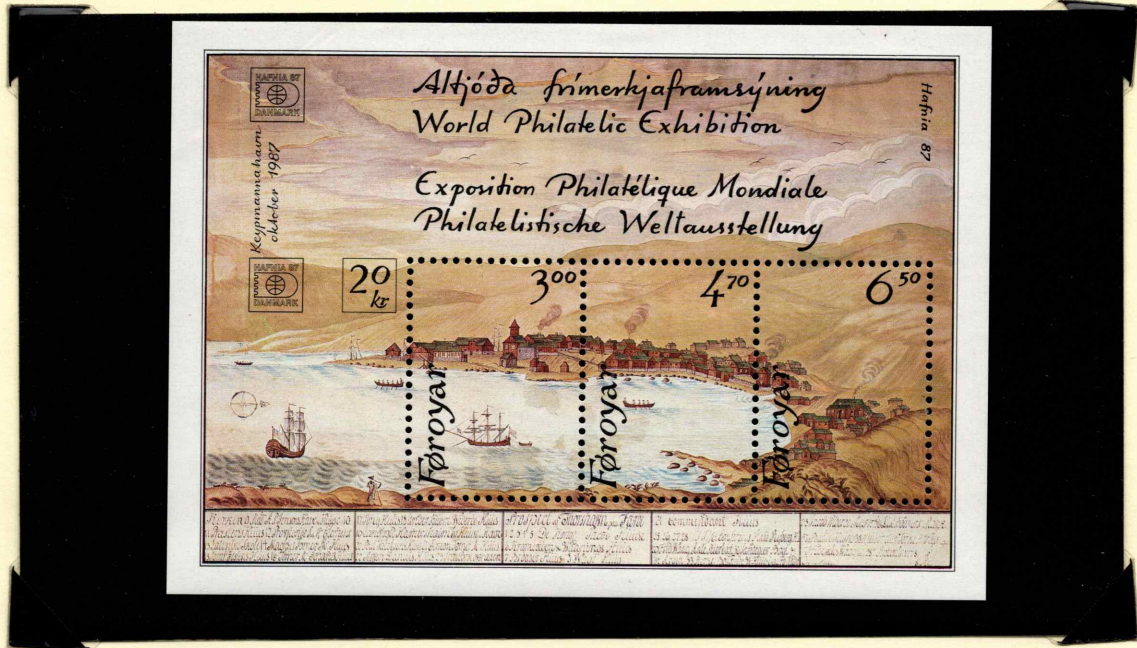
