THE Lincoln Transparent Perforation Measure is made on quite a new plan, and every Collector should possess one.

Perforations are counted by the number of teeth that occur in the space of two centimetres, and not in the actual number of teeth at side or



The Lincoln Perforation Measure has a series of 19 diagrams or gauges, giving the various sizes of perforations, each diagram being in the space of two centimetres. Herewith is a representation of it on a very reduced scale.

The value of the Stamps of Prince Edward Island, British Guiana, Great Britain, Sierra Leone, Austria, Baden, Finland, Lagos, Russia, and many other countries, vary according to the number of perforations, distinguished at a glance by help of the Lincoln Perforation Measure.

Collectors using this Measure avoid the necessity of removing Stamps from their Album when measuring the erforations, as it is printed on a transparent substance, which can be placed over the Stamp however firmly fixed
