The Conkouati-Douli National Park offers a variety of immersive activities to discover its natural and cultural beauties.

- · From July to September, admire humpback whales dancing gracefully in the Atlantic Ocean.
- · while from November to March, witness the magic of sea turtle nesting on the park's beaches;
- Explore the chimpanzee sanctuary managed by HELP Congo for unforgettable encounters with these fascinating primates;
- Explore the rainforest on foot, by canoe or motorized boat, and be surprised by the hidden treasures of this lush ecosystem.
- Thrill-seekers can surf the waves of the Atlantic, sometimes in the company of dolphins and whales.
- Other activities include river nature walks rafting. and visits for cultural total immersion in the richness of the park.
























The Conkouati-Douli National Park, created in 1999 in the southwest of the Republic of Congo, covers an area of **795,500** hectares.

The park is today recognized as a Ramsar site, and is included on the UNESCO World Heritage Tentative List.

This park is home to **exceptional biodiversity**, including 400 species of vertebrates, with emblematic species such as the forest elephant, the gorilla and around 7,000 chimpanzees.

The region, made up of beaches, mangroves, lagoons and forests, protects endangered species such as leatherback turtles, manatees, dolphins and humpback whales.



The Conkouati-Douli National Park aspires to become a model of sustainable and responsible tourism, focused on promoting its unique natural and cultural heritage.

By collaborating with local communities, the park aims to promote environmentally friendly activities, offering visitors full immersion in exceptional biodiversity while raising awareness of its conservation.

This development will strengthen its role as one of the most emblematic conservation sites in Central Africa.

Relax on picturesque beaches, immerse yourself in the wilderness in search of elephants and gorillas, and stay in our lodges immersed in this spectacular setting.






The Park offers a diverse range of accommodation to suit all tastes, while allowing visitors to immerse themselves in the beauty of nature.
