## island escape

*If what you are looking for is just a relaxing day lounging on the beach,  
a visit to Pass Island is our most recommended.*

### THE EXPERIENCE

Enjoy a classic day at the beach, lying on powder fine white sand, underneath the sunshine, with gentle waves lapping at your toes. Exercises of the day are swimming, snorkelling, or even ball games with other tourists in the island!

**Tip:** This is a great half-day afternoon trip, especially if you've just arrived in Busuanga in the morning. Since most tourists are from Coron Town, they leave Pass Island at about 2pm to start their journey home. This means that the island is quieter and a bit more private in the afternoons, when golden sunsets make it quite magical.

### THE DESTINATION

**Pass Island** is the beautiful white sand isle visible from Marina del Sol. This is a laid-back destination perfect for lounging the rest of the day away. A short trail around the island makes for a great nature stroll.

# snorkelling and beach trip

*Our most popular tour option is the perfect introduction to Busuanga, and allows you to experience a mix of its best attractions— wrecks, reefs, and beaches.*

## THE EXPERIENCE

This trip is perfect for those looking to enjoy a bit of history, a lot of marine life, and a whole afternoon in a paradise island that you can practically circle on foot. Your choice of lunch set will be served in a beach tent shaded by coconut trees in Pass Island.

This trip may be done for a whole day (8 hours) or half day (4 hours).

## THE DESTINATIONS

**Lusong Gunboat** is a sunken World War 2 patrol ship that now hosts thousands of fish among soft corals swaying with the current. The wreck is shallow enough for snorkelers and free divers to enjoy.

**Coral Garden** is a protected reef with schools of tropical fish, turtles, and rays swimming along the coral shelf. It is considered one of the best snorkeling and reef dives in the country.

**Pass Island** is the beautiful white sand isle visible from Marina del Sol. This is a laid-back destination perfect for lounging the rest of the day away. A short trail around the island makes for a great nature stroll.

## *busuanga island hopping*

*If an adventure on a deserted beach or discovering several islands is your type of vacation, check out these off-the-beaten-path destinations on the west side of Busuanga.*

### THE EXPERIENCE

This is a full day out at sea getting to know three islands each with a different personality and something unique to offer. Take your pick of adventure or highlight, from the stories of an ancestral island, to intriguing caves, to historic shipwrecks, to relaxing seascapes, to a postcard perfect isle.

Whether you choose to explore to your heart's content, or to stay in the shade to enjoy a picnic lunch, a beautiful day out is in order.

### THE DESTINATIONS

**Isla Malajon/Malajen** is a protected island belonging to and considered sacred by the Tagbanuas. It is more popularly known as Black Island because of the dark and ominous appearance of its tall limestone cliffs.

**Dibutunay Island** is less frequented by tourists and has a pristine white sand beach with cool turquoise water and a very relaxed vibe.

**South Cay** is the middle of a three-islet chain with a spectacular sand bar dotted with cute little cogon huts. It is what you might envision when you think of a deserted island.

## coron island tour

*Lush forests, age-old limestone cliffs, and enchanting lagoons await in this iconic ancestral land. These are the sites that made Coron world-famous.*

### THE EXPERIENCE

Find out why Coron is on so many travel bucket lists when you visit its crystal clear lagoons, all gleaming in different jewel shades of emerald, turquoise, and sapphire.

Our crew will navigate and time your trip to avoid crowds as much as possible, but be prepared to encounter them still. This will be a full day of hiking, swimming, and snorkelling, so make sure you are ready!

### THE DESTINATIONS

**Kayangan Lake** is an immaculate freshwater lake accessed by hiking up a seaside cliff and descending on the other side. It is framed by an untouched forest growing amongst karsts.

**Twin Lagoon** is a brackish body of water separated by a limestone wall. This wall has an opening through which you can swim or kayak. If the tide is high, you'll need to either dive through it or climb a ladder up the wall.

**Siete Pecados** is an award-winning marine protected area with striking blue corals, baby barracudas, and lots more.

You will also visit one of the many small beaches to enjoy your packed lunch.

## road trips



Take a motorcycle to visit Concepcion Falls, Salvacion Town, Ocam-ocam Beach, or Coron Town.

Concepcion Falls is accessible via short mountain bike ride and a 30-minute hike.

Meanwhile, Coron town is reached by venturing east on the highway on an approximately one-hour motorcycle ride.

## calauit safari



The expanse of Calauit Island is a game preserve dedicated to giraffes, zebras, Calamian deers, and other animals. You can also have a lunch stop at a fishpond restaurant in Buluang and buy local handmade baskets at the Bambuhay Weaving Center.
