

Paper Submission Guidelines

The Proceedings of the Conference will be published by [Springer](#) in their Communications in [Communications in Computer and Information Science \(CCIS\) series](#). CCIS is abstracted/indexed in EI-Compendex, DBLP, Google Scholar, Mathematical Reviews, SCImago, and Scopus. CCIS volumes are also submitted for inclusion in ISI Proceedings.

Papers must be unpublished and must not be submitted for publication elsewhere. All papers will be reviewed by the Technical Program Committee and other experts active in the field to ensure high quality and relevance to the conference. Attendance by at least one author of accepted papers is mandatory. Papers should be written in English.

Authors are strongly encouraged to use the [LNCS/CCIS](#) format for their initial submission. Full (Regular) Papers should be 12 to 15 pages, while Short Papers should not be less than 6 pages, in the LNCS/CCIS one-column page format including tables, figures and references. Submissions should include the title, keywords, abstract, list of authors (including contact author) and the full paper document in PDF format. Papers should be submitted through [EasyChair](#). You will have to [login](#) to your account or [register](#) a new account, if you are not yet known to the service, before a submission can be made.
