


### Title: Conversion





Ume Laila (born 1994) is a visual artist currently based in Lahore, Pakistan. She completed her BFA from the College of Art and Design, University of the Punjab, Lahore in 2016. Laila then went on to pursue and complete an MA in Visual Arts from the National College of Arts, Lahore in 2021.

Laila maintains a multidisciplinary art practice through which she explores such as the social contracts inherent within relationships and the aspects that distract from them.
